Why Pray As A Family?

The nuclear family has come under attack in recent years in this nation. There are evil forces trying to pull families apart and distort the concept of what a family is. These forces are spiritual, and it is futile to fight this kind of battle with natural weapons. We need supernatural assistance to overcome them.

We cannot do this in our own power! If we are going to experience lasting change, we need to push back against the opposing forces of our culture and invite God's transforming presence into our homes.

God has an answer. The power released through prayer is what can make the difference. A few things in life *really* matter. One of those is family.

Most people put average effort into too many things, rather than superior thought and extraordinary effort into a few important things. The decision to make family prayer a top priority in the home is one of those small decisions that will produce massive results. It can bring about the things that matter most: a vibrant relationship with the Lord, a close-knit family that is growing spiritually, and a home where patience, joy, and love are practiced and the presence of God is experienced. Like all good investments, you will sow a small seed and reap a big return.
