## WEEKLY REFLECTION

In today's Gospel we hear Luke's version of the Beatitudes. Beatitudes are not rules and regulations, but basic attitudes for Jesus' followers should have in relation to God and others. It calls us to go beyond a minimum requirement mentality of just following the rules. Beatitudes call us to love without limit.

This is a much bigger challenge than just following the rules. This means that we are always called to do more in loving others. This is the difference between a contract and a covenant in marriage. If I just fulfill what is minimally required of a husband in a marriage, I am not much of a husband. Like the covenant relationship in a marriage, I am called to give everything to Jesus Christ. It's not that we always succeed in this, but a beatitude love of God and neighbor is what we should aspire to.

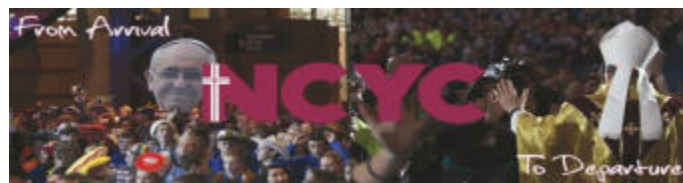

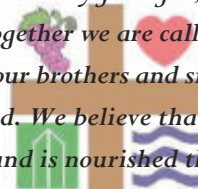
