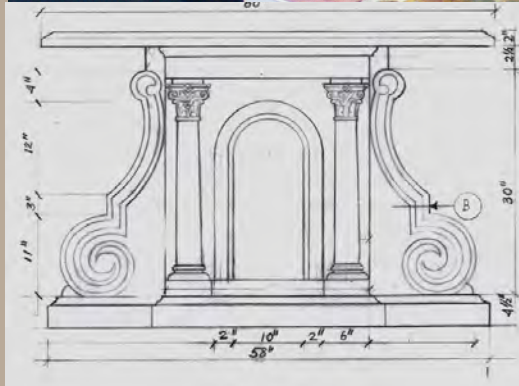

PLASTER RESTORATION & CONSERVATION

Our conservators specialize in plaster preservation techniques that avoid further deterioration, failure, collapse, and the expense of complete reconstruction.

This includes testing and analysis of systemic deterioration and original plaster compositions. With this foundation we can design a comprehensive solution for stabilization, filling, replication, and adhesion of missing plaster elements.

At our plaster fabrication studios in New York and Los Angeles we design, mold, cast, and sculpt for a broad array of architectural applications. Our studio sculptors create new ornamentation and refurbish missing elements, using plaster, glass fiber reinforced gypsum (GFRG), or cast stone.
