

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we hear about the Lord feeding Elijah, strengthening him for his journey to Horeb. We also hear about the Ephesians being encouraged, as are we, to be imitators of Christ. In the Gospel, we read from the "Bread of Life discourse" in the sixth chapter of John.

Jesus offers "the bread that comes down from heaven so that one may eat it and not die". Is it any wonder that "Jews murmured" when they heard this claim of Jesus? A claim made even more incredible when Jesus said, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever".

We have heard those words of Jesus so often that we may not appreciate the unbelievable statement that Jesus is making – eat this bread, live forever! The bread that Jesus offers us is a relationship with him. A relationship nourished by Word and Eucharist. Such a relationship cannot be broken by death. Just as the relationship between Jesus and his heavenly Father was not ended by his death on the cross, so our relationship with Jesus Christ, the Bread of Life, is not ended by our death. It continues; it does not die. It lives on!

Young people often have a great curiosity about matters of faith. We all can help them understand that there are many things that we may never know, but that God has shared with us everything that we need to know to have faith in Jesus. "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever." That claim makes unbelievers murmur – and believers rejoice! (excepts from *Looking to Sunday*© *by Rev. Let us continue to pray that we will grow in our understanding and faith in Jesus through our celebration of the Eucharist. Enjoy a peace filled end of summer and please remember to attend Sunday Mass wherever your travels take you and your family. God bless you!



Every child likes to have new socks and underwear to start a new school year.


The St. Aloysius Social Concerns


