

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we hear the parable of two siblings. Most of the parable concerns the youngest one who takes the inheritance, squanders it, and ends up with nothing. This one returns to the parent, begging for the lowest work and the meager shelter. It's absolutely thrilling to see the parent's response to this wayward offspring; welcome, joy, affection, and relief. We must remember that Jesus is telling this story to the scribes and the Pharisees who do not think wayward people deserve kindness. The older sibling represents them. In mind of the older sibling, the younger one, the parent should punish, humiliate, and put the youngest one through a great deal of pain, so it never does such an irresponsible thing again. The older sibling sees the treatment of the younger sibling as an insult. This indignation baffles the parent, though. The parent says, "Everything I have is yours. If you feel deprived and jealous it is because you are not claiming what I have given." It's here for the taking." We, too, can easily forget everything that God has given to us. We believe we are deprived in some way and so we choose self-righteous anger. Then we wish to hurt instead of heal, punish instead of help. The purpose of the story is to help us remember the immeasurable generosity of God. If we are angry and discontent, we must ask ourselves, "Am I claiming all that God is offering me today?"

Este domingo escuchamos la parábola de dos hermanos. La mayor parte de la parábola se refiere al más joven que toma la herencia, la derrocha y se queda sin nada. Éste vuelve a su padre, rogando por el trabajo más bajo y el abrigo más pobre. Es absolutamente emocionante ver la respuesta del padre a este hijo descarriado; bienvenida, alegría, cariño y alivio.

Debemos recordar que Jesús está contando esta historia a los escribas y fariseos que no creen que las personas descarriadas merecen bondad. El hermano mayor los representa. En la mente del hermano mayor, al menor, el padre lo debe castigar, humillar y hacerlo pasar por un gran dolor, para que nunca vuelva a hacer algo tan irresponsable. El hermano mayor ve el trato del hermano menor como un insulto. Sin embargo, esta indignación desconcierta al padre. El padre dice: "Todo lo que tengo es tuyo. Si te sientes privado y celoso es porque no estás reclamando lo que te he dado". Está aquí para tomarlo". Nosotros también podemos olvidar fácilmente todo lo que Dios nos ha dado. Creemos que estamos privados de alguna manera y por eso elegimos la ira farisaica. Entonces deseamos herir en lugar de curar, castigar en lugar de ayudar. El propósito de la historia es ayudarnos a recordar la generosidad desmedida de Dios. Si estamos enojados y descontentos, debemos preguntarnos: "¿Estoy reclamando todo lo que Dios me ofrece hoy?"
