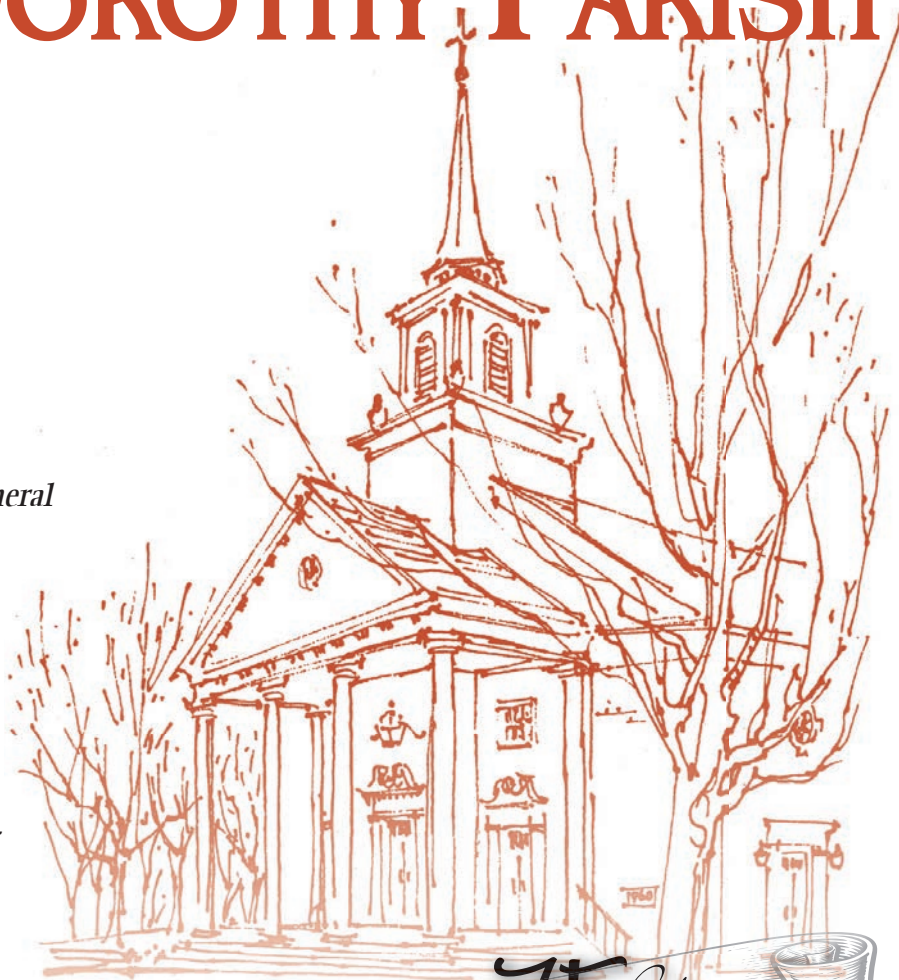

NOTES FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Saint Dorothy Family,

“And who is my neighbor?” This familiar question is asked of Jesus today. We are not told the name of the questioner, but only his occupation; he was a scholar of the law. I would imagine that the initial question in today’s Gospel was a sincere one. The scholar asks, “Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” Jesus asks the scholar to recite what is written in the law. The scholar is able to recite the law, but that is as far as it goes. The law is known to him, but I dare say, it has not penetrated his heart.

The scholar wants to justify himself and so he asks, “who is my neighbor?”. The parable that follows, viz., the Good Samaritan would have been abhorrent to the scholar and all Jews. They couldn’t imagine a Samaritan would help a Jew. They were by definition, mortal enemies!!

Jesus is trying to open up the scholar’s heart. He is asking him to stop trying to minimize the concept of neighbor and to open his eyes and realize, we are all God’s children!! Centuries have passed since Jesus first told of this parable; unfortunately, we are as myopic in our vision today as was the scholar of the law.

We need to pray for the grace to transcend the walls which have been built between neighbors and nations. This task can only start in our own hearts. Today, let us recognize our common brother and sisterhood as we ask Jesus to help us recognize Him in each other.

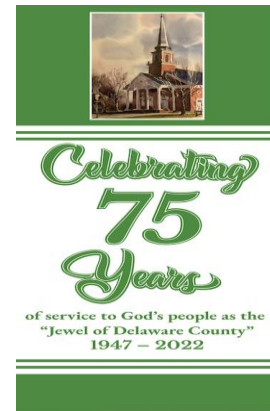
