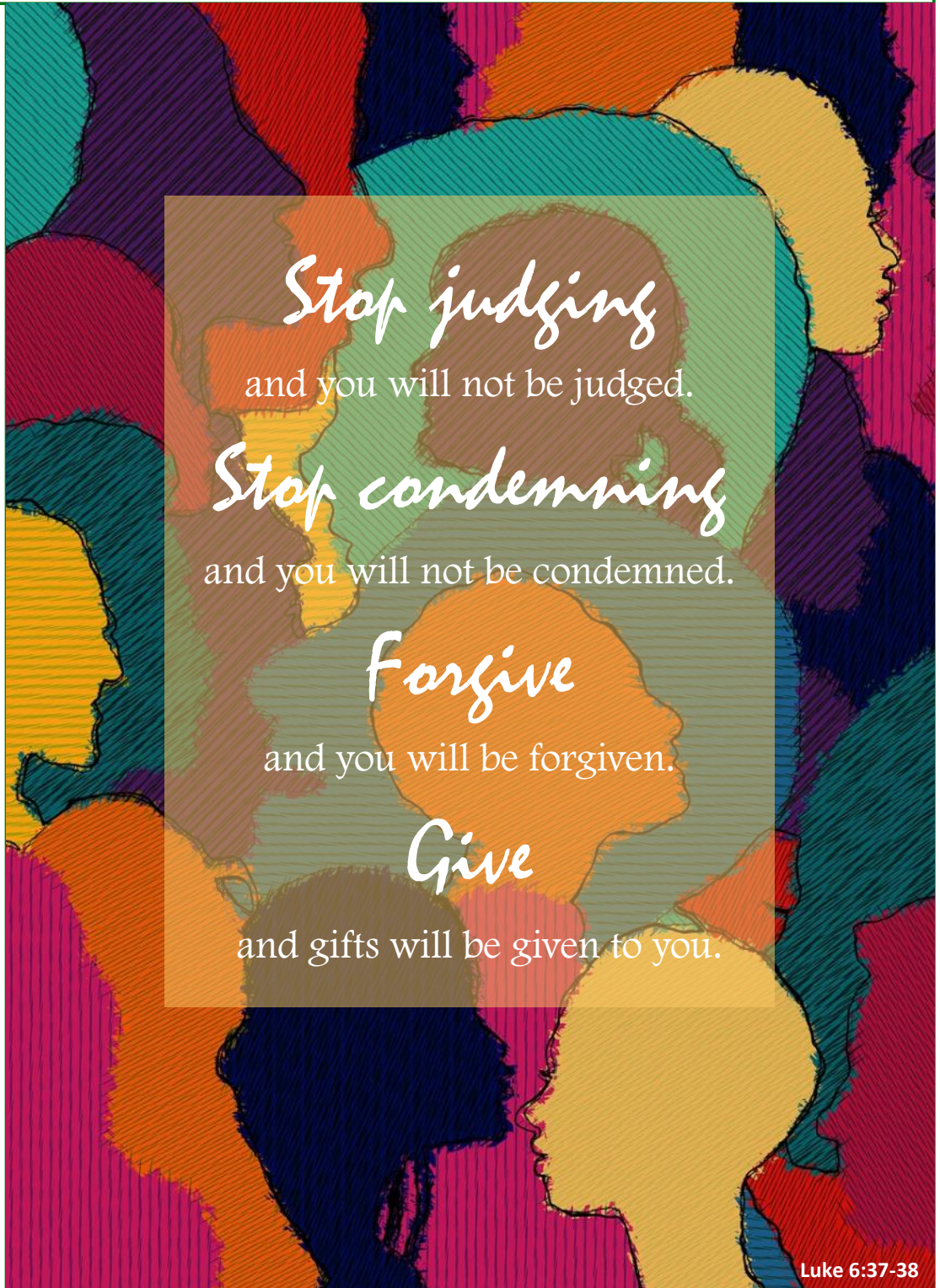

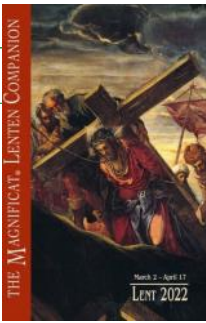

MARCH 10: SOCIAL JUSTICE BOOK CLUB

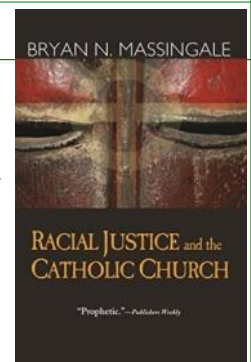

In his thoughtful and provocative book, Fr. 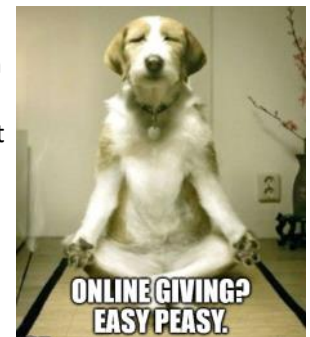

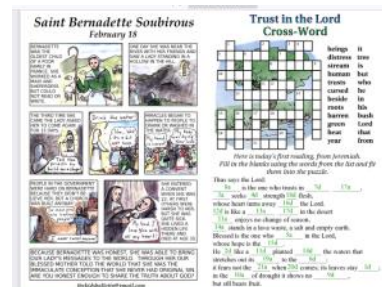

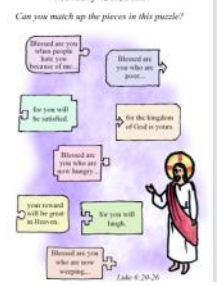
