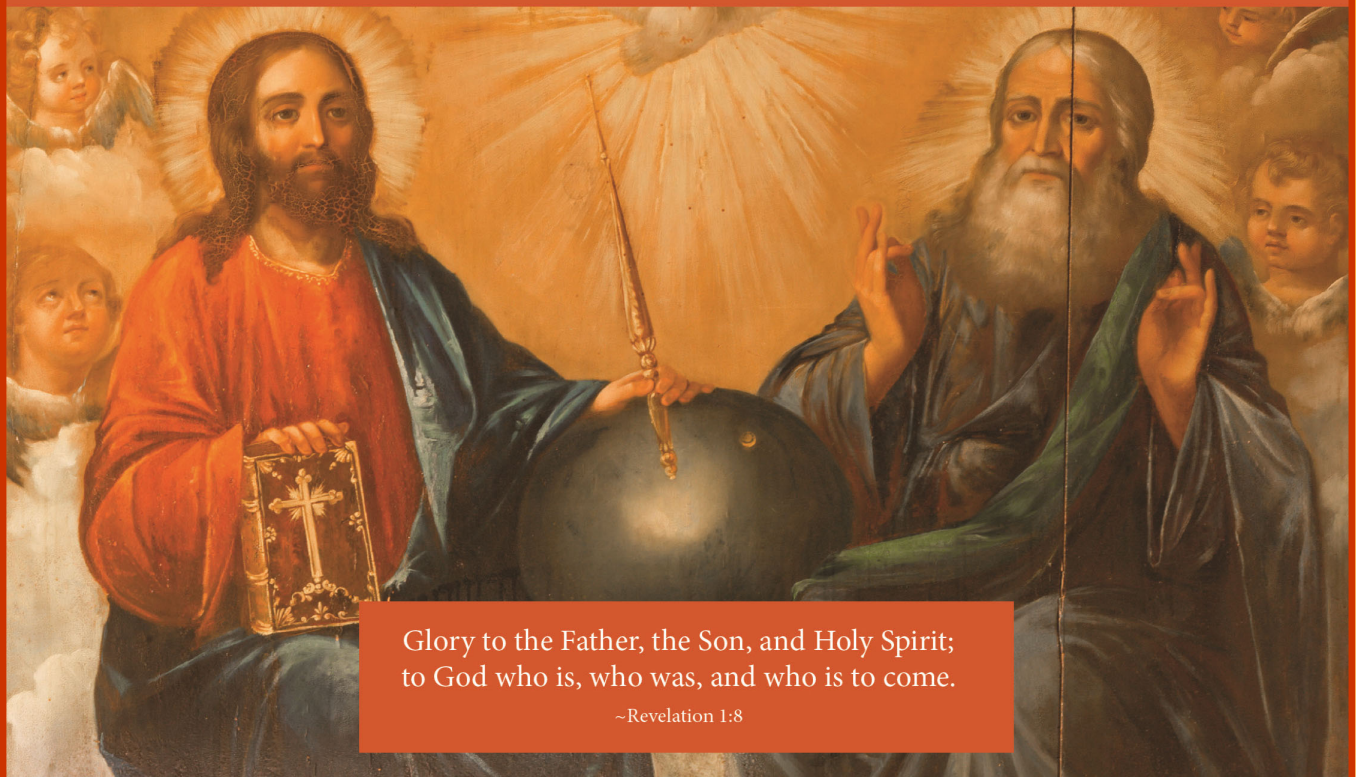

The Eucharist "Source & Summit of the Catholic Faith"

Recent Saints and Their Teachings on the Eucharist

Just as the saints of the early church, the saints of more recent times have consistently professed faith in the Real Presence of Jesus within the humble consecrated Host.

St. Francis of Assisi: He wrote that "everything in man should halt in awe. Let all the world quake and let Heaven exult when Christ the Son of the Living God is there on the altar in the hands of the priest."

St. Anthony of Padua: "We must firmly believe and declare openly that the same body that was born of the Virgin Mary, which was hung on the cross, lay in the tomb, rose on the third day and ascended to the right hand of the Father, was given in food to the Apostles, and now the Church truly consecrates and distributes it to the faithful."

St. Thomas Aquinas: He has been called the "Eucharistic Doctor" for both his inspiring theological writing on the Eucharist in the Summa Theologica and his Eucharistic Hymns and his composition of the Proper of the Mass for the Feast of Corpus Christi. He declared the following about the Eucharist on his death bed: "If in this world there be any knowledge of this Mystery keener than that of faith, I wish now to affirm that I believe in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in this Sacrament, truly God and truly man, the Son of God, the Son of the Virgin Mary. This I believe and hold true and certain."

The Eucharist In Our Lives Today

This holy Sacrament, given to us by a loving God as a perpetual presence among us His children, while keenly adored by the saints and faithful members of the Church throughout the ages, has on the other hand been doubted by many, neglected and ignored by others, received unworthily and desecrated by a few.

For these reasons, and other known only to God, the Lord has seen fit at times to manifest His presence by extraordinary Eucharistic Miracles. These miracles affirm our faith and remind us how privileged we are to share one of the most basic truths and most exalted mystery of the Catholic religion: "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us." - not only in Bethlehem, but in every Catholic tabernacle and in every faithful Catholic heart."

Saint(s) of the Week



St. John Fisher
(1469 – June 22, 1535)
St. Thomas More
(1477— July 6, 1535)
Patrons of Religious Freedom

We celebrate the Feast Day of these two saints together on June 22. It is fitting that these two men have the same feast day as they were both Englishmen martyred within 2 weeks of each other, for the same cause (religious freedom), for the same reason (defending the sanctity of marriage and Papal authority against the state) and at the hand of the same man (King Henry VIII). They were beatified together in 1886 and canonized together by Pope Pius XI in 1935.

John Fisher was born in England and after ordained a priest, the royal family appointed him tutor for Prince Henry who became King Henry VIII. He was name Bishop of Rochester in 1504 and chancellor of Cambridge University. He paid special attention to the poor. Wrote eight books against heresy and Henry, then king, was proud to be his friend.

Thomas More was the son of a lawyer in London. He planned to become a priest, but then entered law school. His three daughters, son, and friends helped make his home a happy place. Besides being a shrewd lawyer he was a charming, witty man who won the friendship of King Henry.

Both John Fisher and Thomas More's friendship with King Henry changed when the king claimed that his marriage to Catherine, his brother's widow, was not valid. Henry had become tired of Catherine and wanted to marry Anne Boleyn. His request for a divorce was refused by the Pope and Bishop Fisher supported the Pope's decision. He was strong enough to resist signing the document that sided with King Henry, though all the other bishops of England signed it. Six month later, Henry, wrote the Oath of Supremacy, claiming that he, was the supreme head of the Catholic Church in England. Again Bishop Fisher refused to sign, making the king angry. The bishop was sentenced to prison on the charge of high treason. The pope declared him a cardinal. He was kept in prison 14 months without a trial. He was condemned to death by beheading.

Thomas More, by now chancellor of England, also refused to approve the divorce. He also refused, like Fisher, to sign the Oath of Supremacy. He was sent to prison and kept for more than a year in the Tower of London. He was beheaded on July 6th. He said to the crowd "I die the king's good servant, but God's first."

Marian Central High School Scholarship



Once again the St. Patrick Knights of Columbus Council #16446 is offering **two \$250 scholarships** to parish students attending Marian Central High School for the upcoming 2019-2020 academic year.

To be eligible the student must

- * Be registered to attend any grade level (9-12) at Marian Central High School for the 2019-2020 school year.
- * Be an active parish member of St. Patrick Church
- * Be currently or previously engaged in service to the St. Patrick parish community.
- * **Submit a completed application by the June 30th deadline.**

All applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Steering Committee. The scholarships will be awarded by mid-July. Applications are available in the church narthex and at the parish office.

As a volunteer you will be asked to come early once a month. Assignments are one time per month; the same week/Mass time each month. For example, if you regularly go to 9am Mass you would be assigned to that Mass either the 1st week of every month, the 2nd week of every month etc. On Saturdays the rosary begins at 3:20PM and on Sundays 30 minutes before Mass time.

Complete training is provided. Someone will do it with you the first couple of times or until you are comfortable. There is a binder with complete meditations and prayers so it's just a matter of reading. Never worry about getting a sub – we have a very devoted team! Want to be Baptized?
Need to make your First Communion?
Never Confirmed?

WHAT IS IT?

- ***RCIA** is the normal way for **unbaptized persons** and those who have been **baptized in another Christian** tradition to become a Catholic
- ***RCIA** is for **Baptized Catholics** who have received no other faith formation and **have not received the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist**
- ***RCIA** is for **children age 7-17 who have not been baptized.** Parents should register for their child.

WHEN IS IT AND WHERE?

- ◇Our 2019-20 parish RCIA for adults and children will begin in September (After Labor Day).
- ◇Participants meet each Sunday after the 9:00AM Mass in the Parish Library.
- ◇Together with their catechists, they explore the elements of the Catholic faith and prepare to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil (April 11, 2020)

How to begin?

- ◇Fill out the St. Patrick RCIA Registration form. It can be found on the parish website at: www.stpatrickmchenry.org/rcia-rite-of-christian-initiation-of-adults or contact the parish office for one to be sent to you
- ◇Submit the filled out form to the parish office.
- ◇You may:

 - ⇒Drop it at the parish office during regular business hours.

Today we celebrate the most Holy Trinity, that is to say the mystery of one God in three distinct persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Some people argue that since it is a mystery we shouldn't try to understand it, or even think about it. The truth is that the more we reflect on the Holy Trinity, the better we live, and the better we live, the more we deepen our reflection on the Trinity. Thinking and living are linked in such a way that if one improves, the other improves too.

Let us do an exercise, think about these special moments in life: when somebody is born, when somebody dies, when a project succeeds or collapses, when we love and feel loved; how do we react? We cry. To cry is something so human, and so intimate that we reserved it for key moments in our lives. I wonder if when somebody dies and meets God face to face, do they cry, laugh, or simply stand in awe contemplating him.


I remember the day I was ordained. It was a very important moment when I felt God's love and presence in a very special way, I could not do anything else but cry.

I believe our tears are more than a human expression; they may become a means to enter into a deeper relationship with the Holy Trinity. When we cry before God in our prayer, and present to him our joy or our sadness, we open that path of intimacy where the love and consolation from God may be manifested in us.

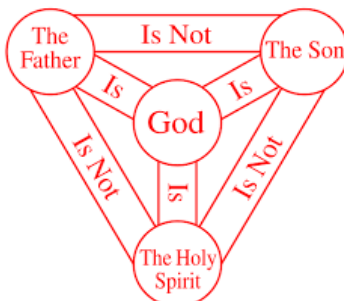

Sacraments

Baptism of Infants or children under 7 years of age:

To schedule a Baptism, please begin by calling the parish office. Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month immediately after the 11AM Mass. Please consider scheduling your child's Baptism before your child is born to ensure an opening in the month of your choice. In addition, a Baptismal preparation class is required for the parents. This is a one session class that is held on the 1st Sunday of each month after the 9AM Mass. Sign-up is required and you may take the class before your child is born. You must be a registered parishioner of St. Patrick prior to scheduling a Baptism.

Sacrament of Marriage:

At St. Patrick, couples planning to marry need to meet with the Pastor before a wedding date can be set. Please contact the parish office to setup an initial meeting **at least 6 months prior to any requested marriage date**. This initial meeting will give you an overview of the requirements for marriage and the preparation required. **At least one of the couple, or their parents, must be registered parishioners for at least 6 months and be active participating members of St. Patrick Church in order to be married at the church.** Both individuals must be at least 19 years of age.

Annulment Process - Information

If you or someone you know needs a previous marriage investigated for its validity or invalidity (the annulment process) so that you may fully participate in your Catholic faith or become Catholic please call the Tribunal Office at 815-399-4300.
