

In Preparation for Pope Francis' Visit to the United States in September: Frequently Asked Questions about the Pope and the Papacy

Q. 1 What are some of the scriptural references to St. Peter and his ministry?

A.1 - Some of the scriptural references to St. Peter and his ministry include:

Matthew 16:16-19

Simon Peter said in reply, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." Jesus said to him in reply, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father. And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

Mark 3:16

[he appointed the Twelve:] Simon, whom he named Peter...

Others include: John 21:15-19, Mark 9:2, Luke 22:31-32, Luke 24:34, 1 Corinthians 15:5

Q. 2 What is the mission Jesus entrusted to Peter and the other disciples?

A. 2 Jesus, the Son of God, is the One sent by the Father. Jesus has a twofold mission: to reveal the Father's love and the forgiveness of sins. Many people followed Jesus and were called "disciples." The word "disciple" means "learner." Jesus called twelve of his disciples and appointed them as His Apostles. The word "Apostle" means "one who is sent." The Twelve Apostles are distinguished by a fourfold criterion: 1) the apostle received a call from Christ to be an Apostle; 2) the apostle received a commission from Christ to preach in His name as an Apostle; 3) the apostle was an eyewitness to the public ministry of Jesus with the special feature of "dwelling with the Lord" (this criterion is suspended for the apostleship of St. Paul); 4) and the apostle is a witness to the resurrected Jesus.

The Apostles form a "college" of those who by office of the Apostle share in the mission of Jesus. In appointing the Apostles, Jesus established them with a unique office in His Church. He also gave them the command to continue His mission, saying, "As the Father has sent me, even so I send you" and he promised to remain with them until the end of the world. Already in the New Testament, the office of Apostle is transmitted to the successors of the Apostles the bishops, as seen in Matthew 26:16-20, the Great Commission. Apostolic Succession continues through to the current day in the college of bishops who as pastors govern the Church in virtue of their unity with the head of the college, the pope.

Q. 3 The office of bishop is divided into three powers or functions. What are they?

A. 3 The three functions or offices into which the office of bishop is divided are the powers/functions of teaching, governing and sanctifying.

Q. 4 Why do we call the Pope the Vicar of Christ?

A. 4 Jesus gave an office uniquely to St. Peter, the first of the Apostles, to be transmitted to the Successors of St. Peter. A vicar is someone who stands in the place of another. Peter was chosen by the Lord himself to be His vicar. He was not elected by the other Apostles to preside over the Church. Jesus Christ specifically prayed for Peter. Now, the cardinals, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to choose the man whom the Lord has destined to be the next Pope.





Congratulations Miss McHenry 2015


St. Patrick extends our congratulations to St. Patrick Church parishioner **Grace Rodriguez** on being crowned **Miss McHenry 2015**.

Vocations Corner: Seeing God at Work

One evening recently, I was talking with a parishioner who had come out from the adoration chapel at my parish. As we were chatting she suddenly got a look of delight in her face and she excitedly exclaimed, "Look!" as she pointed behind me. I turned around and "What? All I see is a few lightning bugs." She said, "Exactly! Aren't they magical!" For a moment I was confused at how she was so excited about these little bugs, but she quickly explained that in the state where she grew up, they didn't have lightning bugs. For this reason they were something new and exciting. I thought about this for a moment and had two thoughts. The first was that she was right, lightning bugs actually are a pretty incredible work of creation on God's part. The second idea was that sometimes when we've grown up with God all around us, that it takes a little effort or even an unexpected reminder to see His work in the midst of our lives. Sometimes people will say that God never seems to speak and reveal His will to them. In response to that I would ask: "Have you tried listening to Him in the little things?" Just like I missed God's hand at work in the lightning bugs and needed a reminder, let this reflection serve as a reminder to you to seek God in the midst of the ordinary day to day things that are and have always been around you!

When we say, "I love Jesus, but hate the Church," we end up losing not only the Church but Jesus too. The challenge is to forgive the Church. This challenge is especially great because the Church seldom asks us for forgiveness, at least not officially. But the Church as an often fallible human organization needs our forgiveness, while the Church as the living Christ among us continues to offer us forgiveness. It is important to think about the Church not as "over there" but as a community of struggling, weak people, of whom we are part and in whom we meet our Lord and Redeemer. (Fr. Henri Nouwen)

Sacraments

Baptism of Infants:

To schedule a Baptism, please begin by calling the parish office. Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month immediately after the 11AM Mass. Please consider scheduling your child's Baptism before your child is born to ensure an opening in the month of your choice. In addition, a Baptismal preparation class is required for the parents. This class is offered on the 1st Sunday of each month after the 9AM Mass. Sign-up is required and you may take the class before your child is born.

Sacrament of Marriage:

At St. Patrick, couples planning to marry need to meet with the Pastor before a wedding date can be set. Please contact the parish office to setup an initial meeting at least 6 months prior to any requested marriage date. This initial meeting will give you an overview of the requirements for marriage and the preparation required. At least one of the couple, or their parents, must be registered parishioners for at least 6 months and be active participating members of St. Patrick Church in order to be married at the church. Both individuals must be at least 19 years of age.




