





Week 3: Seeking and Finding God

We have a purpose; to know and love God. We have a soul that has two functions: knowing and loving. "Saint Thomas Aquinas holds that God is actually the "most knowable" reality, since nothing has more radiance, clarity, and truth than God himself (p.16)." Yet God can seem distant and unreal at times. Why? Although our soul has these two functions, they are crippled by original sin. Our intellect is weak (not lacking) in that we are preoccupied with what is before us and what impacts our senses. It is also lethargic in that we shirk the efforts and sacrifices involved in seeking the truth.

The magnificence of God is all around us in creation. We do not have to look far. As we delve more deeply into the reality of life and creation, the miraculous nature of our existence and the existence of this planet within this solar system just cries out to the glory power and majesty of our Creator.
