



#### **CAN YOU HELP??**

The St. Saviour Media Ministry is looking for people who would be interested in helping us record Masses on the weekends. We established a program whereby we broadcast all of our Masses over the internet. This ministry is especially appreciated by shut-ins, those recovering from an illness, and for out-of-town family members who cannot travel to attend First Communion, Confirmation, Funerals, weddings, or perhaps the first time their young family members serve as altar servers, etc.

We have four cameras located around our church to accomplish this. We have a media control room on the property, and it is from this location that someone controls the various cameras and what is broadcast over the internet. Weekday Masses are recorded unmanned from the HD camera located across from the altar. During the weekend Masses, parishioners control all four cameras with varying views depending on the activity at each Mass.

We established a "Media Ministry" which involves a team of people to operate the camera system from the console located in the Media room. Previous experience is not needed, and the cameras are easy to control. It is not difficult and for those of you who are wondering, it would fulfill your Mass obligation in this ministry so you would not be giving up any additional time.

#### REFLECTION

Take a moment to contemplate the symbols of the season. The crèche tells us the Gospel stories: first from Luke, which details the human birth in a lowly stable and the angels' message to shepherds; and later from Matthew, which describes the arrival of Magi who signify that God's salvation extends to all. The angels stand as heralds of the good news, an emblem for each of us on this solemn feast of our own duty to spread the message that Christ is born and saves us from our sins. The tree stands as a symbol of life, its green branches unfading even in the winter cold, just as God's life remains in us even though our human form should die. The wreath made of evergreens reminds us that God is one, without beginning or end. The candles recall the birth of him who is forever the Light of the world. Today, we celebrate the fact that God came to earth as a beautiful, innocent infant who rejects no one. We rejoice this day in the birth of Christ! And tonight, we remember that Jesus Christ came into this world quietly, humbly, and gracefully, an example of how we should live our lives.

# QUESTION AND ANSWER



What can I do to help our family practice our faith each day?

Some families practice their religion together as just another event on their schedule: go to church, observe Lent, help at the parish picnic, go to a meeting, volunteer time, make your confession, use your envelope. The focus needs to be on who we are: God's people, in relationship with him, loved, forgiven and redeemed, and called to live and proclaim the Gospel. Our awareness of God's presence and our sense of mission are supported by the daily rituals, celebrations, and traditions that help us stay focused. Sharing our faith strengthens us and clarifies the beliefs and values of Christian living.

Daily family practices include time for prayer-before meals, before bed, before important meetings and activities. Attend Sunday Mass together and discuss the homily afterward. Create family celebrations for holy days and holidays. Make religion a regular part of your discussions. Include others, especially the elderly and the less fortunate in your activities and charitable efforts. By applying the virtues of faith, hope, and love to each day, faith becomes part of who your family is. It influences how you act towards others, what you value, and how mindful of God you are. Faith is the leaven of life that helps all of us rise to our calling and dignity as God's people.


