The purpose of this information is to give you an outline of the services and assistance available to older persons in Inyo and Mono Counties through IMAAA. Many other agencies provide services and IMAAA can link or refer you to these agencies.

Background:

The Inyo Mono Area Agency on Aging, IMAAA, is concerned with all matters that relate to the needs of older persons in Inyo and Mono Counties. IMAAA is a jointpowers agency created by the Inyo and Mono County Supervisors and designated by the California Department of Aging, CDA, to plan, deliver, and <u>administer services for</u> <u>older persons and certain disabled adults</u>. IMAAA is one of nearly 700 local area agencies across the nation, which

provides access to senior services.

Services of the Inyo and Mono Senior Programs:

IMAAA is operated through the Inyo County Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and programs are provided in Mono County through a contract with Mono County Social Services. Programs in Inyo County are provided directly by HHS.

Assisted Transportation

For seniors who need transportation but cannot ride the Inyo Mono Transit bus due to physical limitations, escorted rides to essential services can be arranged by appointment.

Medical Transportation Services

Many medical services needed by residents must be obtained outside the Inyo/ Mono area. We may be able to schedule rides to out-of-area medical appointments if you have no public or private alternative. Requires 7-10 day advance notice.

In-Home Caregiver Services

A variety of services to assist older persons in their homes are available. In-home services include:

Respite Care to aid the primary caregiver of a senior at home through Day Care or relief workers. Also Caregiver Counseling and education.

Homemaker Aide and Personal Care Services, such as laundry, household cleaning and bathing assistance in the homes of eligible seniors.

Emergency Response System (ERS) devices are placed in the homes of eligible frail elderly persons and can be used to summon assistance.

The Crisis Walk-In Clinics (CWIC) provide urgent mental health services to residents of the County of San Bernardino. CWIC provides crisis intervention, crisis risk assessments, medications, referrals to county, contract and community resources, education and when necessary evaluations for hospitalization. Consumers will be screened for appropriateness of service and will either be provided referrals or admitted in to CWIC for additional assessment. 



Random Facts, Tidbits, and Information

TYPES OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program

- allows a family to move into a unit of their choice if the property owner chooses to participate in the HCV Program. It is commonly referred to as a Section 8 Voucher.

Project Based Voucher (PBV) Program -

provides rental assistance at select apartment complexes within the city. The voucher is tied to the apartment complex, so the individual does not have to have a Section 8 voucher.

Low Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) Properties - the LIHTC program gives State and local LIHTC-allocating agencies the authority to issue tax credits for the purchase, rehabilitation, or new construction of rental housing targeted to lower-income households. The apartment complex receives the tax credit, which is passed onto the tenant in the form of subsidized rent.

Section 811 Supportive Housing for Persons with Disabilities program - HUD provides funding to develop and subsidize rental housing with the availability of supportive services for very low- and extremely low-income adults with disabilities.

Section 202 Supportive Housing for the Elderly Program – provides very lowincome elderly with options that allow them to live independently, but in an environment that provides support activities such as cleaning, cooking, transportation, etc. The program is similar to Supportive Housing for Persons with Disabilities (Section 811).

LOW INCOME HOUSEHOLD DEVELOPMENTS

The following housing authorities offer rental subsidies for low-income families and adults through their Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program and other project-based voucher programs. Each operates on a waiting list and it can take three to seven years, or longer, to receive a Section 8 Voucher. Project-based vouchers may operate on a shorter waiting list.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING INCOME AND VOUCHERS DID YOU KNOW?

IHSS income is excludable for parent providers If you are an IHSS parent provider and have a Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher, the Public Housing Authority excludes the IHSS income you receive for taking care of your child with a developmental disability at home for the purposes of calculating your rent.

(Housing Choice Voucher Program Guidebook (7420.10g) – Exhibit 5-2 – Income Inclusions & Exclusions)

Properties receiving Low-Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC) to reduce rents is also subject to the same income exclusion.

The Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) program gives States and local housing agencies money to acquire, develop, or rehabilitate rental housing/apartments that in turn offer reduced rent to tenants. Low-income households do not need a Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher to reside in one of the LIHTC properties, as the building itself receives the tax credit to make it affordable to the tenant. LIHTC properties also exclude IHSS income for parent providers when the child (or adult child) lives in the same home. Food stamps are also not included in income determination. *(California Tax Credit Allocation Committee*)

Other income exclusions for Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher recipients

The Housing Authority also does not include the following as income when calculating your rent (aka total tenant payment):

- Income from employment of children under the age of 18 years;
- Payments received for the care of foster children or foster adults
- Lump-sum additions to family assets, such as inheritances, insurance payments;
- Income of a live-in aide (as defined in Section 5.403);
- Amounts received from a State or local employment training program

(24 CFR 5.609)

The Housing Authority will also deduct the following when determining your adjusted income for Section 8 and other public housing programs:

- Unreimbursed childcare expenses
- Unreimbursed medical expenses for persons with disabilities and elderly
- Unreimbursed disability expenses

(24 CFR 5.611)



Accessibility improvements (widen doorways, ramp with hand rails, handicap accessible toilet, grab bars, or replace tub with accessible shower) can make a residence more accessible for a person with a permanent physical disability living in a low income household within Kern County Planning and Community Development Department entitlement jurisdiction. Income verification is required for all people living at the residence. Rental property and owner-occupied property can be improved under the program. In all cases, the owner of the property must agree to the specific improvements. The applicant must have a permanent physical disability which restricts access to or around the residence. The disability must be verified by a doctor evaluation form completed by the applicant's primary physician familiar with the disability. After review of the application and doctor evaluation, the Kern County Planning and Community Development Department will contact the applicant for an inspection of the residence to determine specific needs and eligible improvements. All work must be completed by a California licensed and insured contractor.

An inspection of the property is done to determine the work needed. All work must be completed by a California licensed and insured contractor. Eligible improvements include repairs to the air condition, heating, roof, electrical, plumbing, carpet, linoleum, windows, insulation, painting.

Available to owner occupied single-family residence with gross household income below the income limit adjusted for household size and subject to change at the discretion of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). There must be sufficient equity to secure a first or second mortgage. A second mortgage is only considered if the existing first mortgage is a fixed interest rate, fully amortized, current loan. A property with a reverse mortgage is not eligible. A deed of trust is recorded on the property to secure the County of Kern deed of trust mortgage loan. Monthly payments can be made and the balance paid in full at any time. Loan renewed every five years only if the owner occupies the residence, property taxes and insurance are current, and household income is below the annual income limit.






