History


- Founded 1919 as PWO AG Headquarter in Oberkirch, Germany





Platform

- Low level of structured data
- Limited functionalities
- Easy to manipulate
- Currentness of masterdata (existing calculations)

Quote Calculation

Different calculation sheets in the PWO group


- > Different elements of costs in the individual cost pool
- > Different unterstanding based on different calculation sheets
- > High effort to create an intercompany calculation (increasing intercompany business)

Consistency

> Comparability of Quote / Pre / Post Calculation is linked with high effort
