"... a frightening and almost incomprehensible tie-in between satanists, intelligence professionals and military mind control experimentation seemed to be emerging."

It seemed appropriate to interview R. Roy Blake, author of Objective Evil: Satanic Cults in U.S. Intelligence, as close to Halloween as possible. Blake, however, was quick to explain that the subject was no laughing matter, and that connections between satanic cults and intelligence agencies go back a long way. The October 24, 1995 edition of *Wake Up America* talk show, hosted by Sue Ellen Lefton, featured Blake, who has documented an undeniable link between satanists and intelligence agencies. Intelligence agencies have been interested in the cults largely because of their success in maintaining the secrecy of networks of clandestine cultists—but most especially because of their expertise in mind control.

Famous individuals with satanic/intelligence ties include Albert Pike, who was head of Confederate intelligence and co-founder of the Ku Klux Klan during and after the Civil War; but perhaps best known as the author of the Masonic 'bible' Morals and Dogma and the most prominent of the Masons. Aleister Crowley, who referred to himself as "the Beast 666", had ties to British and French intelligence. In the contemporary United States, Colonel Michael Aquino formed his own satanic "temple", when he decided that the Church of Satan was not sufficiently serious about their 'religion'. Aquino, who signs his name "*and to the profane, The Second Beast of Revelations*," reports only to the Joint Chiefs of Staff and has either headed up or been

involved in psychological operations (mind control) for both Army Intelligence and the Defense Intelligence Agency since the Vietnam War.

Although Aquino has often been somewhat of an embarrassment to the Army, it is clear that high military officials have gone out of their way not only to defend his unorthodox beliefs, but perhaps even to cover up his possible involvement in a daycare child molestation scandal at the Presidio Army Base in San Francisco. In that case, at least 59 children eventually testified to some sort of abuse; five children under five years of age were medically confirmed to have contracted the sexually-transmitted disease *Chlamydia*; and one little girl was able to identify not only Aquino and his wife, but also to point out Aquino's house on Leavenworth Street in San Francisco and to describe rooms within the Aquino

mansion. Aquino was, however, never charged with a crime. The Chief of Police of San Francisco, in a letter to Blake, did not answer the question as to whether the Federal Government interfered with the investigation of Aquino. The Army had made the statement at that time that Aquino had knowledge which could dramatically affect the U.S.' "national interests".

Blake first became aware of the satanic-intelligence tie while doing research for an article concerning an "accidental" killing that involved members of a teenage satanic cult in Aurora, Colorado. In that incident, teenagers told Blake that the teenage satanist who "accidentally" killed the other teenager had such a mental hold over the other teenagers that they at first told police that an unknown intruder had committed the killing, a story that only broke down when police separated the teenagers for further

"On October 13, 1994, The Rocky Mountain News reported that a police search of an abandoned funeral home in Fort Myers, Florida, presented some bizarre and gruesome findings. One was the corpse of an infant being carried about in a briefcase. The investigation was begun when authorities discovered nine corpses in a storage locker being rented by the Finley Carter Funeral Home. At least a dozen and up to 22 other improperly disposed of bodies were found on a complete search of the facility."

questioning. In the chaos created by the killing, teenagers told of a ritual site underneath the runways at Stapleton Airport that had seen both animal and human sacrificial ceremonies. The cult, although containing a large number of high school students known officially as "stoners" both for their love of heavy metal music and prodigious use of drugs, was not lead by teens but rather by older and apparently respectable "pillars of the community" drawn from the professions, business community, local government and the military. As soon as the dust began to settle, however, the teenage sources uncharacteristically refused to talk further, leading Blake to speculate that the cult was once again back in business.

Further research was greatly aided by a

unique local organization known as Justus Unlimited, a support group for ritual abuse survivors headquartered in the Denver area. Justus receives mail and calls from alleged abuse survivors from all over the world, averaging about 500 to 600 calls a week; it is also a clearing house for often extremely sensitive information on the inner workings of satanic cults. In addition to the almost unbelievable insight that abuse survivors give on the workings of the various satanic cults, about 10% to 15% of survivors appeared to have been victims of what Justus co-founder Faith Donaldson referred to as "militaristic abuse". Militaristic abuse survivors, in addition to the most "conventional" satanic rituals, most often recalled being subjected to what seemed to be psychological or mind control experimentation, conducted on what

seemed to be official U.S. military facilities.

Some survivors seemed to have remembered financial transactions between satanic cult leaders and military intelligence officials. One survivor, who was embroiled in a custody fight for a daughter born into a satanic cult, co-authored an enormous affidavit that alleged not only military intelligence involvement in the cult but also the involvement of high governmental officials; including at least two present and former U.S. senators, a half dozen congressmen and at least one former member of a presidential cabinet. The militaristic abuse accusations were given credibility by the MKUltra revelations of the Senate's Church hearings of the mid-70s; numerous volumes written about the occultic connections of intelligence



THE WEWELSBURG VALHALLA (Hall of the Dead), a satanic ritual chamber in the north tower of Wewelsburg Castle, Westphalia, Germany. It is the site of black magic rituals conducted by both the Nazi SS and Lt. Col. Michael Aquino. SS Commandant Heinrich Himmler believed the site to be the center of the world, the point where the greatest evil was concentrated. Aquino himself conducted his own ceremony for the purpose of creating a portal for the powers of darkness to descend upon the earth.

The Wewelsburg Castle was restored with slave labor from nearby Niederhagen concentration camp; 1,235 of those inmates DIED during the restoration of the castle. A Nazi swastika is, to this day, embedded in the ceiling of the chamber.

"In another case, a Santa Cruz, California, based satanic cult was reported to have taken a portable crematorium with them during sacrificial rituals in the Santa Cruz mountains. These rituals were purportedly guarded by members of the cult armed with high-powered rifles."

A page from a Temple of Set pamphlet, in which the high priest of the Temple of Set, Lt. Col. Michael Aquino, compares himself to "The Omen" movie character Damien Thorn. Aquino has made the outright claim that the movie was based upon his own life. Indeed, he insists that he is "The Second Beast of the Revelations" spoken of in the Bible. This could all be laughed off as the ravings of a madman, if it weren't for the very disturbing fact that Lt. Col. Aquino is a highly-placed official in the Army's PSYOPS division: an expert in propaganda and psychological warfare (and therefore privy to mind control projects that are restricted from public scrutiny); and obviously well-protected by friends in high places. Aquino has the tendency to play down his extensive military background when carrying out his "public relations" for satanism.

"Apparently Aquino has mastered the ability (which is important for any good government official) of believing two diametrically opposed suppositions simultaneously and being able to express them in a way that serves to confuse the unwary." (R. Roy Blake)

mind control experimentation such as Gordon Thomas' Journey Into Madness; but most particularly by a paper co-written by then-Major and satanic high priest Michael Aquino, entitled *From Psyops to Mindwar*. *Mindwar*, written long after President Ford issued a Presidential Executive Order compelling the CIA to cease mind control experimentation, contended not only that the government had a mind control capability that could reach any point in the world that ordinary media could reach, but also stated that the government should seek to target not only nations and populations hostile to the U.S., *but the U.S. civilian population as well*. It listed at least three technical means for such efforts, the most effective of which seemed to be the use of Extremely Low Frequency (ELF) waves, which could be incorporated into media broadcasts. Intelligence experimentation into mind control has not ceased, as was confirmed by the results of a Freedom of Information Act request that Blake received from the Defense Intelligence Agency (the alleged inheritors of MKUltra files and technology) which revealed that the DIA had at least 59 documents on such

experimentation, originating *after* the Ford Executive Order and only one of those documents was entirely releasable to the public.

During a tour of NATO facilities in Europe sponsored by the World Affairs Council, Aquino made what he referred to as a “pilgrimage” to Heinrich Himmler's “magic” castle at Wewelsburg, Germany. SS Oberfuhrer Himmler incorporated early German paganism with Thule Society satanism, and used concentration camp labor in renovating the castle. He sought to make the SS into something much deeper than a paramilitary force —a sort of satanic priesthood, which Aquino refers to in letters to members of his Temple as the “other Dark Order”. Aquino tells his followers that he conducted a “Working” (black magic ritual) in Wewelsburg's Valhalla (Hall of the Dead). The Hall of the Dead, according to Aquino and presumably Himmler, was both the center of the world and the point at which the forces of evil were most powerful in the world. According to their beliefs, black magical ceremonies conducted at this site would have the greatest power.

The Temple of Set's satanic theology teaches its members that there is a coming apocalypse that will spare only the satanic elect. Blake finds circumstantial evidence that suggests that this “apocalypse” might well be the result of the introduction of genetically-engineered viruses into populated areas; for which vaccines would only be available to satanists and their allies. As an aside, the government has quietly resumed biological warfare testing at Dugway Proving Grounds in Utah.

The Army's Handbook for Chaplains currently includes sections on the “Church of Satan” as well as Aquino's own “Temple of Set”. Surprisingly (and reportedly as a result of Aquino's influence) the Handbook paints satanism in glowing terms, stating that it is “pro-life” and based on “enlightened self-interest”. Aquino, who briefly appeared on a number of talk shows in the late 1980s, continues to have followers in high places: including politicians at the highest levels; intelligence operatives; and members of some of the military's most elite units, such as the Navy SEALs and Army Rangers.

According to the November 16, 1987 Newsweek article entitled "The Second Beast of Revelation", the Army had known about Aquino's "religion" since 1981, but granted him top secret security clearances at the National Defense University in Washington, D.C. —even after the outrageous allegations of child molestation at the Presidio became well-known. Likewise, Aquino's outspoken interest in Nazi occultic rituals did not appear to slow his military career. This was all, of course, before the military officially condoned satanism.

The following pages are taken from the Army's Handbook for Chaplains, wherein sections on the Church of Satan and the Temple of Set are now provided for soldiers interested in those branches of "American religion".

OTHER NAMES BY WHICH KNOWN: Within this religion its principles are termed "Setian," and individual affiliates are termed "Setians." As the original god Set was later caricatured as the "Satan" of Judaeo-Christianity, Christians often interpret this religion as "Satanism" and its affiliates as "Satanists." Setians accept such labels only to the extent that the Christian Satan represents certain qualities of individualism and independence. Setians reject any interpretation of Satanism that glorifies or promotes evil or destructiveness.

LEADERSHIP: Michael A. Aquino, High Priest of Set

MEMBERSHIP: Not published

HISTORICAL ORIGINS: Together with the Priesthood of Horus, the original Priesthood of Set was the most ancient of the Egyptian religious orders, dating (by surviving predynastic images of Set) to at least 3200 B.C.E. and by the Egyptians' own astronomically-based records to approximately 5000 B.C.E. The Setian religion played a prominent role in Egyptian society throughout its development, to include being the state religion of the XIX-XX dynasties of the New Empire. It appears to have been eclipsed approximately 1000 B.C.E.

Thereafter what may be termed the "Satanic tradition" survived in successive Western civilizations in the form of philosophies and/or god-figures focusing on "awareness and activity beyond the natural order." Such range from the Prometheus of the Hellenes and the Lucifer of Christianity to the individualistic philosophies of Pythagoras, Plato, and Nietzsche. The Romantic movement of the 1800s dramatized the Christian Devil as a heroic, Miltonian symbol, thus setting the stage for the eventual formation of the Church of Satan in 1966.

The Temple of Set was founded in 1975 by the international Priesthood of the Church of Satan (whose founder, Anton LaVey, had announced intentions to commercialize it). Simultaneously the anti-Christian mythology and orientation of the Church of Satan were discarded in favor of the completely distinct character of the original Egyptian Priesthood of Set. The Temple of Set was incorporated as a non-profit church in California in

Great Mother Goddess. Ritual follows the movement of the sun and Neo-Pagans see themselves as reviving the pre-Christian religion of the Mediterranean Basin and manifest as Norse, Druid, or Wiccan in format. By far the Wiccans compose the largest segment of the Neo-Pagan community. Wicca or Witchcraft is derived from the ancient religion practiced in Western Europe, especially the British Isles.

Magick, an essential element in modern Wicca, seeks mastery of all the forces believed to control the world. Witches believe in the ancient maxim of "as above, so below," and in their worship seek to create a microcosm, a magical image of the whole. The universe is generally viewed as a sphere. The magical circle, drawn at the beginning of all magical rituals, is a circle of the microcosm intersecting the floor.

Witchcraft had grown slowly until the repeal of the last of England's Witchcraft laws in the 1950s. Growth accelerated in the 1960s and 1970s. There are no less than thirty different Wicca groups and hundreds of Wiccan covens functioning in the United States. The Gardnerians are one of the oldest modern Wicca groups. They trace their history to Gerald B. Gardner, who created the current Wiccan revival. However, most Wiccans now follow the eclectic practice which values creativity and is constantly changing and evolving while remaining within the basic nature Goddess orientation. During the 1980s many Neo-Pagans and Wiccans joined the Armed Forces Network. Recently they have formed a network to assist in their relating to the military. The Network may be contacted through its newsletter, *Pagan Military Network*, 829 Lynnhaven Parkway, Virginia Beach, VA 23452.

Secrecy is a major element of the existence of both Witchcraft and Wicca (discussed below). Secrecy is protective (known members often lose jobs, friends or status), and serves to guard the sacred mysteries of the

SATANISM

Often confused with Neo-Paganism and Wicca, Satanism is the worship of Satan (also known as Baphomet or Lucifer). Classical Satanism, often involving "black masses," human sacrifice, and other sacrilegious or illegal acts, is now rare. Modern Satanism is based on both the knowledge of ritual magick and the "anti-establishment" mood of the 1960s. It is related to classical Satanism more in image than substance, and generally focuses on "rational self-interest with ritualistic trappings." Modern Satanism began with the Church of Satan, founded by Anton LaVey in 1966. From it, in the 1970s, several groups emerged and quickly disappeared. The Temple of Set is the only substantive offshoot to survive into the 1980s.

Modern Satanists have found it relevant to distinguish themselves from what is termed contemporary devil-worship. By Devil-worship is meant the various informal activities which have appeared in the 1980s around teenage use of Satanic symbols, killings of serial killers professing to have been worshipping the Devil, and various reports of "Satanic" crime. Modern
