

At the same time students will accumulate points towards medals. After the initial *Opening Ceremony*, events can be completed in any order. Individual books can only be counted in one event. Please keep your score on the sheet provided on page 8 in this booklet.

To have the points added to your total you will need to have the event signed by a teacher.

Competing in the Reading Olympics

Individual events

Individual points are earned for the individual events entered.

You can earn extra points by completing team events (as a team) or by entering special events once a fortnight.

Team events

This is a group of girls within your class. The team can have a maximum of FOUR members.

There are team events, and if your team completes the team events you all get the points to add to your individual score.

Country

This is your class competing against the other classes.

Your class will need to give your country a name.

Special Events

These will be offered once a fortnight. If you complete these events you will earn extra points for your team.

You will need to check the library page on the portal for the 'special events'. Once you have completed the activity you will need to see the teacher librarian to get collect your points.

Medals

The points you earn through reading will earn you medals.

Please keep a tally of your medals on the score sheet on page 8.

GOLD = 200 points **SILVER** = 150 points **BRONZE** = 100 points



Random Reading Test (RRT)

What is a Random Reading Test?

This is where a teacher will ask questions about books you read for different events. If you cannot answer the questions about the books for that event, you will be disqualified for this event and the points will be removed from your total.

When will the Random Reading Test happen?

At any time over the Reading Olympics the teachers reserve the right to do a RRT. This could happen at any time, in anyway and anywhere.








Reading Olympics
