Equally important is the opportunity for us to understand the significant challenges facing our community.

- Tommy Grimes of The Grimes Companies, Peter Anderson of Pattillo Construction, Joe Waryold of Maxwell House, and Robert Hays of Florida Rock (Capitol Concrete Division) are four of seven members of the newly created Industrial Preservation Commission. This commission will provide oversight to insure that we maintain the 56,000 acres of industrially designated property in Duval County.
- Nick Cevera of Swisher and Peter Anderson of Pattillo Construction represented FCMA interests in discussions on the Stormwater Fee. This process is tied to the city's responsibility for cleaning up the St. Johns River.
- Mike Templeton of LyondellBasell continues to serve as chairman of the City's Environmental Protection Board.
- Councilman Michael Corrigan recently completed his term as President of the City Council.

These individuals are but a few of you that serve in numerous capacities within our region. FCMA's goal is to promote the appointment of other extraordinarily qualified individuals within our ranks to represent manufacturing's viewpoint to community leaders by joining with them in developing policies to guide our region.

I welcome your participation and your contributions. We will only be successful in telling the positive story of manufacturing if we are known within our community on a number of fronts. Serving in appointive capacity is an excellent way of accomplishing that goal. Be ready for Blair's call!


