# ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST NORTH ATLANTIC CORPORATION AND KEVIN MITCHELL

The Commission imposed sanctions against North Atlantic Corporation and Kevin Mitchell in the previously instituted public administrative proceedings against them. North Atlantic and Mitchell consented to the entry of an Order which finds that they willfully made misrepresentations in North Atlantic's broker-dealer registration application concerning Mitchell's regulatory history. Furthermore, the Order finds that Mitchell willfully made misrepresentations in EuroGold Exchange Ltd.'s investment adviser registration application concerning his regulatory history.

Accordingly, the Commission denied North Atlantic's broker dealer application; provided, however, that it may resubmit an amended application; and, that it retain outside counsel to review all filings. The Commission barred Mitchell from association with any registered entity; provided, however, that in four years Mitchell may apply to become so associated, provided that for a period of one year, said association will be in a supervised capacity. # CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

#### ACTIONS AGAINST ALLURE COSMETICS AND OTHERS

The Commission filed a Complaint for Injunctive and Other Relief in the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey against Allure Cosmetics, Ltd., Kurt Tauss, Gattini Corporation, and Pietro Gattini. Allure Cosmetics, Ltd. (Allure) is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business in Hackensack, New Jersey. Tauss was the president, chief executive officer, and chairman of the board of Allure from 1983 until May 1988. Gattini owns Gattini Corporation and has been the president, chief executive officer, and chairman of the board of Allure since May of 1988.

The Complaint alleges, among other things, that Allure and Tauss committed violations of antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the Exchange Act) in failing to disclose in the registration statement for an initial public offering of Allure common stock in August 1986, and in certain subsequent filings with the Commission, that a substantial portion of the proceeds of the offering would be used to make payments to Tauss and

The Make-Up Center of 55th St., Ltd (MUC), an entity controlled by Tauss. In addition, the Complaint alleges that Allure and Tauss violated the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act by making materially false and misleading statements and omissions of material facts in Allure's Forms 10-K and 10-Q regarding Allure's sales of goods to the MUC. #### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

## NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and National's subsidiary companies, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation, Penn-York Energy Corporation and Seneca Resources Corporation (Subsidiaries), to amend National's existing authority to issue and sell, prior to December 31, 1990, up to an aggregate principal amount \$150 million of its debt securities consisting of

debentures and medium-term notes and to contribute the proceeds to the Subsidiaries, by seeking an exemption from the redemption provisions of the <u>Statement of Policy Regarding First Mortgage Bonds Subject to the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935</u> regarding the debentures. #### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

On June 7, National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-90-11) pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, with the Commission to amend comparison procedures applicable to its Municipal Comparison System and Automated Bond System. Publication of the proposal in the Federal Register is expected to be made during the week of July 2, 1990. (Rel. 34-28168)

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> (SR-MSE-90-09) to amend the Exchange's fee schedule to reduce the current fee for processing electronic transmissions of Regulation T extension requests from \$1.00 to \$.50 per extension request has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. ## APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-89-5). The proposal amends the NASD's Board of Governors' Interpretation on Prompt Receipt and Delivery of Securities contained in the NASD Rules of Fair Practice. The proposal provides that no NASD member shall effect a short sale for its own account in any security unless the member makes an affirmative determination that it can borrow the securities of otherwise provide for their delivery by settlement date. The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> (SR-BSE-85-3) relating to amendments to the BSE's Constitution. (Rel. 34-28191)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-90-30). The proposal amends the NASD's Board of Governors' Interpretation on Prompt Receipt and Delivery of Securities and also proposes a new section to the NASD's Uniform Practice Code setting forth examples of the terms "fully hedged" and "fully arbitraged".
