

### Tech Talk **ANOTHER LIGHTNING** STRIKE!



Listeners may recall that, early last year, our transmitter on the Sugarloaf Range, was damaged by a significant lightning strike. This put Rhema off-air for a period of time, while repairs were arranged.

Prior to our annual fundraiser, Rhemathon 2020, David Badcock (our Chief Engineer) became aware of an intermittent fault on our 6 bay broadcast antenna. The problem was the result of another lightning strike that also caused water ingress. Two antenna coaxial cable feeds were completely disconnected from the 6 bay antenna. An assessment was made and replacement parts were ordered. There was a 12-week delay on delivery, with the great concern being our ability to stay on air over this time period.

We praise God that, despite this damage, Rhema continued to broadcast, with just some decrease in reception in places on the fringes of our broadcast area. Rhema has now returned to full signal strength, broadcasting at 10kWatts of power.


