This Page: Tomatoes!!!

Cherry Tomatoes	
<p>Black Cherry (h) Black cherry tomatoes look like large maroon-purple-brown grapes. They have a deep rich flavor typical of black tomatoes. Prolific.</p>	
<p>Gardener's Delight (h) My favorite red cherry tomato-deep, sweet taste with a bit of tang. Amazing producers.</p>	
<p>Pink Bumblebee Pink with light pink, yellow, orange stripes. Sweet.</p>	
<p>Sunrise Bumblebee Round yellow with red stripes and combinations of yellows and reds on the interior too. Sweet and tangy.</p>	
<p>Sungold This is my favorite cherry tomato-unbelievably sweet with a fruity taste that is unique. I will never have a summer without sungolds.</p>	
<p>Supersweet 100 Classic red cherry tomato, incredibly sweet, simply amazing! This plant can grow to be 30 feet long tall if staked and trained!</p>	
<p>Yellow Pear (h) Slightly larger than a typical cherry tomato, these unique yellow pear-shaped tomatoes have a light taste and are excellent producers.</p>	
Midsize	
<p>Garden Peach (h) Beautiful 2-4 oz tomatoes that blush pink when ripe. They have a mild, fruity taste and a lovely fuzzy skin (like a peach!). Plant produces fruit late into the fall.</p>	
<p>Glacier Small-medium 1-2" red tomatoes on a compact plant that is great for containers.</p>	

Midsize and Paste	
<p>Amish Paste (h) Excellent paste variety- good for cooking, canning r fresh eating.</p>	
<p>San Marzano (h) Excellent paste tomato from Italy- peels and cooks down quickly.</p>	
<p>Speckled Roman Paste Beautiful pink-red paste tomatoes with yellow-orange streaks. Eat fresh in tomato salad or cook into sauce.</p>	
Big Beefsteak/ Slicers	
<p>Cherokee Purple (h) This purple-red-pink heirloom produces big tomatoes with a deep, almost smoky taste. Excellent for slicing on to sandwiches add depth to salad.</p>	
<p>Golden Jubilee (h) Incredibly prolific producer of large orange-yellow tomatoes with a bright tomato taste that almost feels like it is glowing.</p>	
<p>Green Zebra These green-with yellow stripe tomatoes are often referred to as heirloom because of their unique taste and color, super rich, sweet and tangy tomatoes. My kids love these.</p>	
<p>Hillbilly Potato Leaf (h) Incredible bicolor tomatoes. Large yellow-orange with red on blossom end. Inside is full of yellow and red marbeling.</p>	
<p>Italian Heirloom (h) Looking for a reliable simple big red tomato? Plant produces many large tomatoes in a season, with the just-right summer tomato taste. Excellent fresh and for cooking.</p>	
<p>Pink Brandywine (h) Superb heirloom. Solid, meaty interior with pink-red exterior. Not a prolific producer, but the few tomatoes you get will be large and amazing.</p>	
<p>Tiffen Mennonite (h) Another incredible heirloom, from the Mennonites in Wisconsin. We grew a 2-lb tiffen in 2017 and it was as tasty as it was big.</p>

Peppers and Eggplants from Daisy Hill Farm

Sweet Peppers	
<p>Carmen</p> <p>The Sweet Carmen Pepper is a long, bright red, thin walled pepper when ripe. Excellent for roasting or fresh eating. Will produce peppers until the frost hits.</p>	
<p>Gilboa Orange</p> <p>Blocky orange bell pepper that does well in the North, ripening in September most years.</p>	
<p>King of the North (h)</p> <p>Good producer, can use as either green or red (when ripe), does well even in cooler summers.</p>	
<p>Lunchbox</p> <p>Lunchbox Peppers are mature when they are 2-3 inches in length. They are amazingly sweet and quite prolific. It is not always easy to get peppers to ripen in New England during our short growing season, but these little treats do the trick!</p>	
<p>Sweet Pimento</p> <p>The Sweet Pimento Pepper is a small (2-3") bright red pepper when ripe. Excellent for baking or fresh eating. Thick-walled, sweet. Prolific producer!</p>	









Hot Peppers	
<p>Carrot Bomb</p> <p>Fedco seeds says "An explosion of round 1-2" shiny bright tangerine baubles blow up the pepper patch on sturdy 2-2½" plants. The heat is comparable to a mild jalapeño but will vary with weather conditions. A bold spark in salsas, kebabs, stir-fries or the pickle jar"</p>	
<p>Czech Black</p> <p>Black peppers turn reddish when ripe, 2 1/2" long, heat is less than a jalapeno. Very prolific, reliable even in "bad" pepper years.</p>	
<p>Habanero</p> <p>VERY hot. Each plant should set 10-20 2" wrinkled fruits that turn from dark green to tangerine. Benefits from a cover when summer nights dip below 70.</p>	
<p>Hidalgo Serrano</p> <p>Hotter than a jalapeño these plants produce many fruits which Fedco describes as "bright, fruity hot flavor lingers in the front of the mouth and makes your taste buds tingle all over," Green peppers ripen to red.</p>	
<p>Ring-O-Fire Cayenne</p> <p>HOT! 4" fruits mature from green to shiny fire engine red. Prolific plant.</p>	
<p>Thai (h)</p> <p>Small upright 1" peppers ripen to bright red and each plant can produce 200 peppers!</p>	
Eggplants	
<p>Casper</p> <p>Excellent producer even in cooler summers. Fruits are 5-6" and skin is ivory colored, flesh not bitter and some say it has a "mushroom" like taste.</p>	
<p>Diamond</p> <p>Dark purple, mild in flavor and easy to grow! They set fruit early and keep producing until the autumn frosts. Mature size is approximately 6 inches long.</p>	
<p>Fairy Tale</p> <p>Compact plants with small 2-4" light purple and white striped eggplants. No bitterness, few seeds</p>	
<p>Pingtung Long</p> <p>Chinese Eggplant that is thin and long- up to 12". Shiny, deep lavender fruits with a sweetish taste. Skin is thin and does not need to be peeled. Plants are hardy, prolific and disease resistant.</p>	
<p>Patio Baby</p> <p>Excellent variety for containers. Compact spineless plant produces 2-3" fruits throughout the season. Plant is 18-24" tall at maturity.</p>	








Heirloom Perennial Herbs & Flowers	
<p>Chives</p> <p>Thin green onions, always the first plant in spring to reemerge from the cold ground. Produces purple flowers which are also edible.</p>	
<p>Lavender</p> <p>Lavender flowers have a soothing aroma. Leaves and flowers are both edible. Said to repel insects and calm the mind.</p>	
<p>Mint</p> <p>Common mint used in teas and mojitos. Grow it in containers or far away from your vegetable plot so that it doesn't invade.</p>	
<p>Oregano</p> <p>Fedco says "The true culinary herb for Greek and Italian cooking. Low-growing perennial with fragrant dull green and purple leaves and white flowers."</p>	
<p>Rosemary</p> <p>The needle-like savory leaves of rosemary are strong and are often used in meat dishes. Rosemary will overwinter if protected.</p>	
<p>Sage</p> <p>Dusty green soft leaves add a texture component to your perennial garden. Sage survives surprisingly well through the winter. We use the leaves all winter long to make a butter sage pasta sauce, to flavor soups and beef dishes.</p>	
<p>German Thyme</p> <p>Taller variety that can grow up to 12" tall and spreads out in mats. It is excellent for flavoring soups, meat dishes and gravies. Purple flower spikes attract pollinators</p>	
<p>Blanket Flower</p> <p>Beautiful daisy-like flowers with bicolor petals-red and yellow. Makes an excellent cut flower.</p>	
<p>Hyssop</p> <p>Member of the mint family, produces lavender spikes all season long, great for pollinators.</p>	
<p>Purple Coneflower</p> <p>Purple coneflower is also known as echinacea and grows to 2-4' tall. Great cut flower. Purple-pink petals surround large spiky orange center.</p>	
<p>Shasta Daisy</p> <p>Excellent cut flower, Bright white petals surround yellow center.</p>	

Annual Herbs	
<p>Basil: Rosie</p> <p>Tall lavender flower spikes and strong stems make this an excellent addition to bouquets. Mild basil taste mixed with anise.</p>	
<p>Basil: Round Midnight Purple</p> <p>Beautiful purple leaves have a different taste- one that feels like it is tinged with nutmeg and is savory. Beautiful purple flower spikes.</p>	
<p>Basil: Sweet (h)</p> <p>This basil is the traditional star of summer. Use it fresh in sandwiches, in salads, on pasta, or make your own pesto!</p>	
<p>Basil: Thai</p> <p>Beautiful plant with green leaves and purple stems and flowers. Strong licorice-anise flavor, often used in Thai cooking.</p>	
<p>Chamomile (h)</p> <p>This plant has fern like green foliage and tiny flowers that are often used in tea for their calming effects.</p>	
<p>Cilantro</p> <p>Use the leaves in a multitude of dishes- Indian, Mexican, etc. If plant is allowed to go to seed, then you get a second treat- coriander.</p>	
<p>Dill</p> <p>Large, ferny dill leaves. Sautee with carrots for an excellent side dish!</p>	
<p>Parsley: Giant Italian</p> <p>Large, flat rich dark green leaves.</p>

<p>Bachelor Button: Beautiful purple, pink and blue puff ball flowers that are edible and can add visual interest to any dish! Bachelor Buttons may self-seed. Plant height: 16-24".</p>		<p>Bean: Dragon's Tongue (bush) (h) Prolific heirloom with delicious beautiful green and purple mottled beans. Turn green when cooked.</p>	
<p>Calendula: Pacific Beauty Mix Edible petals-they are tangy, slightly bitter petals and can be used to garnish salads or main dishes. Plant height: 18-24".</p>		<p>Maxibel Haricot Vert (bush) Thin French beans, sweet and tender. These haricot verts grow longer than average and hold well if you forget to pick them for a while.</p>	
<p>Cosmos: Sensation Mix Large bright blooms of red, pink, magenta and white flowers with feathery foliage. Blooms entire season. 4-5'</p>		<p>Provider (bush) (h) Dependable producers of the classic green bean. Produces 2 big flushes of beans.</p>	
<p>Cosmos: Double Click Mix Semi-double and double puffy blooms in shades of pink, white, plum and magenta. Sturdy stems make these great cut flowers. 4'</p>		<p>Red Noodle Yard Long (pole) Absolutely stunning 14-18" long burgundy beans that are stringless with sweet Asian bean flavor.</p>	
<p>Marigold: Crackerjack Double bloomed-orange, gold and yellow flowers on plants 3' tall.</p>		<p>Cabbage: Ruby Perfection Grow through the season and harvest in late summer or fall. Becomes even sweeter after the first frost!</p>	
<p>Marigold: Queen Sophia Dwarf French marigold produces a range of different colored flowers</p>		<p>Celeriac: Brilliant This plant is grown for its gnarly root, not leaves. It has a delicious celery-potato taste and is excellent in soups or mashed.</p>	
<p>Nasturtium: Mix A range of bright orange, red and yellows. Fun, edible flower with a peppery taste- brightens up any dish. Leaves are round with succulent stems and are also edible. 8" tall, will spread if given room</p>		<p>Celery: Tango Excellent variety for New England- tolerates shifts in temperature and water. We harvested our plants for 4 months last year!</p>	
<p>Sunflower: Dwarf: Hella Sonnenblume Many flowers are produced from one plant. Strong stems support these 4" diameter yellow-petaled blooms.</p>		<p>Cucumber: Pickling Sets fruit without pollination, so may be kept under row cover. Small cukes, plants have high disease resistance.</p>	
<p>Sunflower: Dwarf: Teddy Bear This dwarf sunflower has puffy 3-5" yellow blooms. Perfect for containers or in borders and super fun for kids! Height: 2-3 ft</p>		<p>Cucumber: Slicing Dark green classic slicing cucumbers, 8-9", produce throughout season</p>	
<p>Zinnia: CA Giant Mix (h) Range of saturated colors on both single and double blooms. 30" tall. Make excellent cut flowers. Deadhead to encourage more flowers.</p>		<p>Fennel: Perfection This fennel variety does well in our variable New England soils. Fedco says that fennel is a "perennial grown as an annual with a licorice taste. Tender stalks and leaves are good for relishes, salads and garden munchies. May also be grilled, sautéed or steamed</p>	
<p>Zinnia: Oklahoma Ivory (h) 2" double and semi-double blooms in colors ranging from creamy white to light yellow. Increased resistance to powdery mildew. Ht 3 ft</p>		<p>Zinnia: Red Scarlet (h) Deep red flowers with yellow and red centers. Plant height 30-36"</p>	

<p>Kale: Red Russian Excellent all-around kale variety. Stems have a purplish hue and leaves are light blue-green. Harvest all season</p>		<p>Scallions: Purple Beautiful purple bunching onions will come back year after year in your garden! One of the first spring treats!</p>	
<p>Kale: Toscano Also known as lacinato or dinosaur kale. Plant once and harvest outer leaves throughout the whole season! Darker, ruffled thick leaves.</p>		<p>Scallions: White Classic white bunching onions- perfect for soups, and a myriad of other dishes! Will last the whole year and come back next spring in your garden!</p>	
<p>Kale: Purple Curly Incredibly green-deep purple curly kale leaves become more purple with colder temperatures. Tasty sweet kale is the perfect edible ornamental.</p>		<p>Yellow Summer Squash Pick when small for tender squash to eat raw, sauté or grill.</p>	
<p>Leeks: King Richard They start small, but these leeks will be large and ready to eat in the early fall.</p>		<p>Green Dunja Zucchini Excellent early green zucchini, powdery mildew resistant. Harvest young (6-8")</p>	
<p>Lettuce Mix An assortment of colors and shapes makes for a delicious and beautiful salad.</p>		<p>Waltham Butternut Squash Big fruits with smaller seed cavities make this winter squash super valuable! Squashes grow to be 4-5 lbs, but may be harvested younger. Classic, delicious butternut flavor. Keeps for months after harvest.</p>	
<p>Onion: Yellow Storage (New York Early)</p>		<p>Swiss Chard: Rainbow Mix Swiss chard is a relative of beets and is easy to grow. Cut outer leaves and stems all season long for a beautiful rainbow set of "greens" . Perfect for sautéing with garlic.</p>	
<p>Onion: Red Storage (Red Cabernet)</p>		<p>Onion: Sweet (Walla Walla)</p>
