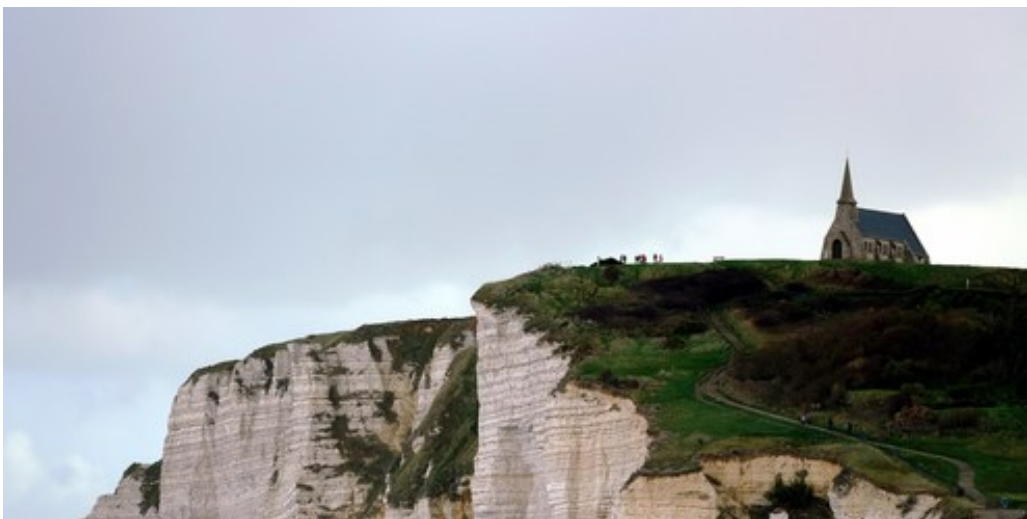

Your bike ride takes you on the trails throughout the provincial town of Les Andelys, followed by a hike where you will ascend 300 feet (90 meters) up to the medieval masterpiece, Chateau Gaillard, for magnificent views of Les Andelys and the Seine.

Get inspired on your visit to this commune in Paris' northwest suburbs where, during the 19th century, artists including, Paul Cézanne, Camille Pissarro and Jean-Baptiste-Camille Corot. Most notably, however, was Vincent van Gogh, who lived and painted here. The guided visit includes the final resting cemetery of both Vincent and Theo van Gogh, as well as a look inside the boarding house where Vincent last lived.

PREPARING FOR YOUR ADVENTURE

Required Travel Documentation

If you are a U.S. citizen, you will need a valid passport to enter France; and return to the United States. It must be valid for 6 months beyond your intended stay and have at least 2 blank pages remaining. Allow yourself sufficient time to have your application processed if you are applying for a new passport or renewing an expired passport. Visit the U.S. Department of State for more details.

Note: You do not need a visa to travel to France for less than 90 days, within each 180-day period.

Guests 17 years of age or younger may be required to show additional documentation when traveling with a single parent.

If you are not a U.S. citizen, please check with the Consulate or Embassy for France for information on documentation requirements.

What to Pack

Please limit your baggage to one piece of luggage per person plus one carry-on. With frequent security changes, we recommend that you check with your air carrier as well as the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) for current restrictions.

Do I need vaccinations to travel to this country?

If you are a U.S. citizen, you do not need vaccinations to travel to France. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please check your local requirements on vaccinations for travel to this country.

What airport do I fly into and out of?

Arrival: We will pick you up from Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) on your arrival day. Your flight should arrive no later than 1:00 PM.

Departure: At the conclusion of your adventure, we will transfer you to Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) for your return flight home.

If you are continuing with the *Adventures by Disney* optional extension package at the Disneyland Paris Resort, you will be transferred to Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) for your return flight from the Disneyland Paris Resort.

Are transfers included if I arrive or depart from different locations or at different times from the itinerary?

No. Transfers are only included from Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) and Hilton Paris Opera Hotel.

Can I extend my vacation beyond the *Adventures by Disney* itinerary?

Yes, you may book an optional extension package at the Disneyland Paris Resort after the Seine River Cruise itinerary. You may also choose to extend your vacation with a night at the Hilton Paris Opera Hotel. The Disneyland Paris Resort optional extension package and stay at the Hilton Paris Opera Hotel may be booked through *Adventures by Disney* Travel Services, Inc. in conjunction with a river cruise package and cannot be combined with any other offer. How will our group travel between destinations?

Throughout the adventure, Guests will travel between destinations on board the AmaWaterways ship. During excursions, Guests will travel by motor coach.

How strenuous are the activities?

While this adventure is not considered physically strenuous, there are some activity options that are, indeed, physically strenuous, while others are not. Most days will include 2 or more hours of walking, sometimes on uneven cobblestone streets. The escorted bike rides are not suited for a child who is 10 years old or younger. For all bike rides, we strongly recommend that Guests be in shape, know how to ride a bike, have ridden a bike recently and know that the bike ride will take place on a solid surface, gravel and cobblestoned, through towns, along the river, near traffic, crossing streets, etc. Bike trails are not on grass. Please note: Guest wishing to bike on their own can visit the Cruise Manager to reserve a bicycle. There will be a couple of “junior” bikes onboard that are suited for a 9-year-old to 12-year-old child, depending on their size. However the Cruise Manager will need to see in person any child under 9 year old or any small child, since small-sized bikes and helmets need to be outsourced. Also, since we always put safety first and try to prevent accidents, if the Cruise Manager determines that a child shouldn't ride a bike, he or she will give that child other activity options.

While nearly all of the trip's featured activities are gentle if examined separately, the full range of activities requires a moderate amount of stamina in order to get the most of your vacation.

Can I sail if I am pregnant?

What ages are appropriate for this adventure?

While we welcome children ages 4 and up for our River Cruise trip, we recommend that children be at least 8 years old at the time of travel. This is based on several factors, such as flight time, jet lag, time zone differences between destinations, vacation duration, extended hours of daily activity programming and the amount of physical activity (e.g., walking) involved.
