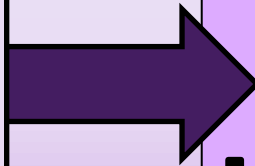

Senior Expectations

"Students must maintain the established criteria for **academic achievement, attendance, and behavior** during their senior year to be allowed to participate in school activities, the senior closing events, and/or the graduation ceremony"

Ed Code 48200 and Board Policy 5127



What does this mean?

Jurupa Hills expects its senior class to:

- Set and maintain **high academic standards** for themselves and work towards achieving their academic goals
- Attend class **regularly and on time**
- Communicate with teachers and the attendance office if you will miss class
- Behave according to our school-wide expectations

Academics

- Complete all academic requirements by May 28, 2021
- Pass all required classes (with a letter grade of D or better), earning a *minimum* of 230 credits
- Complete and verify, through the Counseling Department, any additional credits needed from Adult Education and/or college classes by May 28, 2021
- Financial Aid: Complete FAFSA or Dream Act
- Complete college applications (deadlines vary)

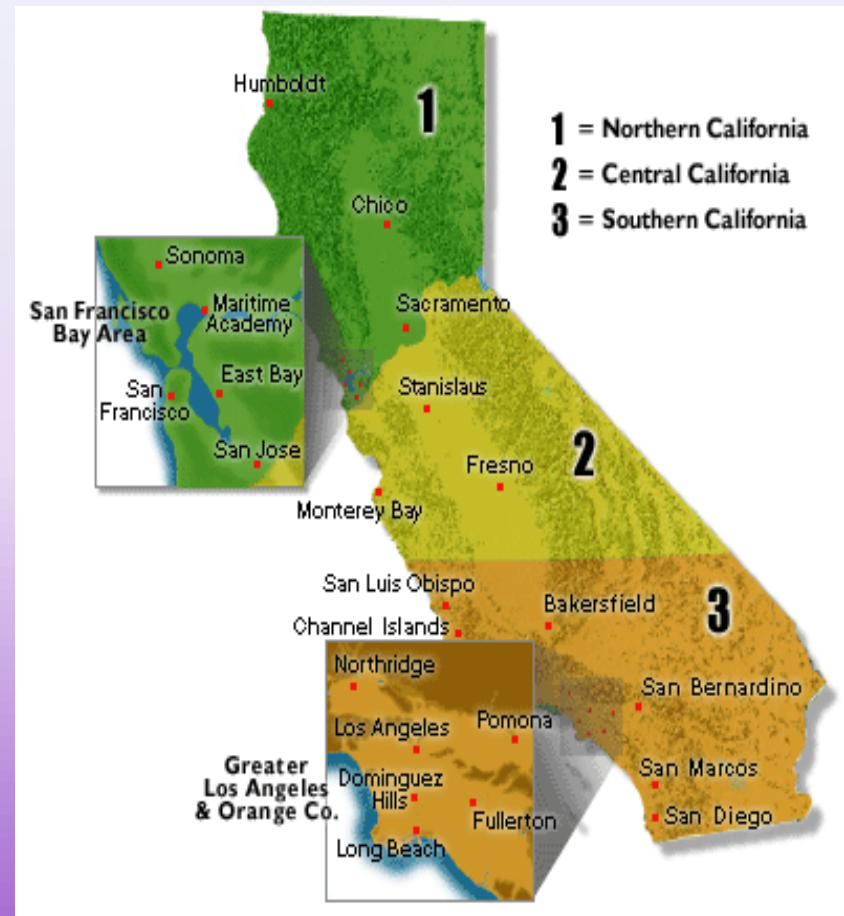
