6 Session Class for Third Grade Children and Their Parents






Confirmation Instruction


Wednesday Morning Men's Bible Study

Shame is everywhere we look. It hides in the shadows, lies to us, and shackles us in the prison of our past. It hides in plain sight and holds us back in ways we do not realize. But the truth is that God is not only more powerful than anything we've ever done but also stronger than anything ever done to us. We can grow in freedom and strength!

In this five-session video Bible Study, Christine Caine explores the often-hidden consequences of shame--in her own life and the lives of so many women--and shows how you can move from a shame-filled life to a shame-free future. As she leads you into God's Word, you will see how God is bigger than your mistakes, your inadequacies, and your limitations. You will see that you are not fundamentally flawed and that you are worthy of acceptance.
