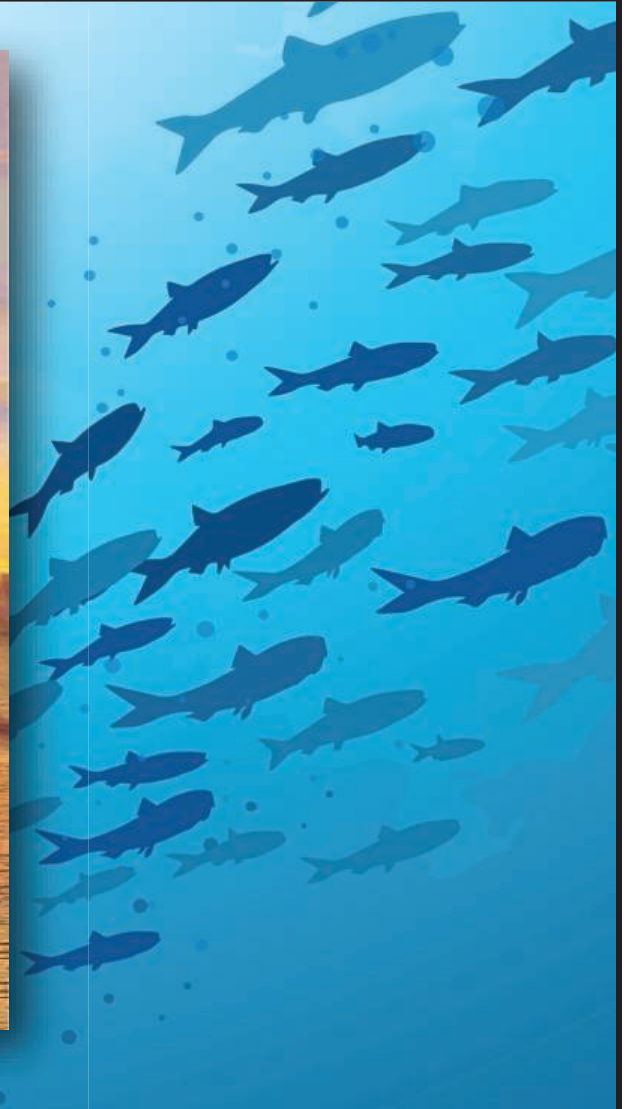

Reading I: Isaiah 8: 23-9: 3

The passage concludes the prophet's memoirs. The rod and staff describe Assyria's oppression. Now that very darkness will end and Yahweh has come to the rescue, bringing great light.

Reading II: I Corinthians 1: 10-13, 17

Paul confronts the problem of divisions within the community with their individual divisive slogans. True preaching releases the power of the one true gospel.

The Gospel: Matthew 4: 12-23 or 4: 12-17

Jesus takes up John the Baptist's ministry in the safer territory of Galilee. Jesus for Matthew is the Promised One of Israel. Jesus urges repentance and the near arrival of God's kingdom, the object of Christian hope.

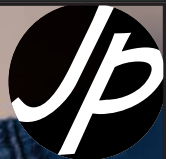
