The Sutton Trust has been monitoring young people's expectations of going to university since 2003. Our latest polling, <u>'University Aspirations 2018'</u>, surveyed young people aged 11-16 on their attitudes towards higher education and found

that:

- 75% of young people think going to university is important to get on in life, the lowest level since 2010.
- **Disadvantaged young people are less likely** than their peers to believe that they are likely to go into higher education (67% compared to 79%).
- Nearly half of young people likely to go to university are worried about the cost of higher education. This concern is particularly pronounced among young people from the least affluent families (58% compared with 41% in 'high affluence' households).

To make sure that the cost of going to university is not a barrier to anyone, we are calling on the Government to restore maintenance grants and review the case for means-tested tuition fees. We are also calling for more higher and degree apprenticeships, so that there is a viable alternative to university.
