As we continue to celebrate the extraordinary life of Congressman Lewis, who died July 17, 2020 at 80 years old, we remember the history of "Bloody Sunday" – the courageous march that he led across the Edmund Pettus Bridge in Selma, Alabama, in 1965 – and the savage beating he and other activists endured there for the right to vote.
