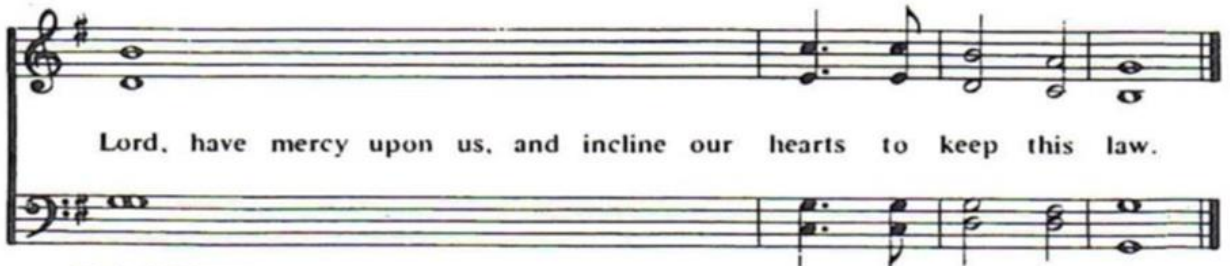

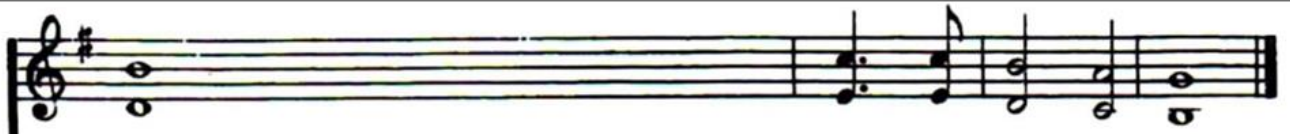

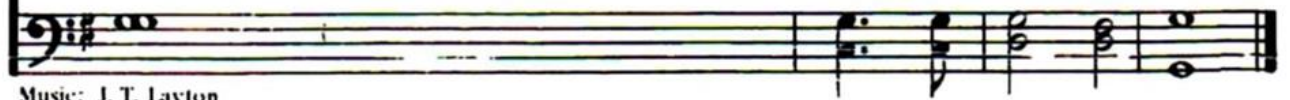

Reverend Clark was deeply inspired by the late Reverend Doctor Johnie Carlisle, Jr., by the way he approached ministry and service both to God and mankind. It was an opportunity afford by Reverend Carlisle that introduced him to preaching.

Reverend Clark entered the class of admission, for the Southern California Annual Conference and was admitted to Conference in 1997. He was ordained a Deacon in 1999, and an itinerant elder in 2001. His first charge was Providence First AME Church in Lompoc, CA (November 2002); were he served for four years. The Right Reverend John R. Bryant assigned him to Allen Chapel AME Church in San Bernardino, CA (November 2006). On December 15, 2007; Bishop Bryant reassigned Reverend Clark as the Pastor of Saint Paul AME Church, were he has served for thirteen years. On October 15, 2020 the Right Reverend Clement W. Fugh appointed Reverend Clark as the Pastor of Price Chapel AME Church, Los Angeles. Pastor Clark is married to Sister Le'Shune Clark (29 years), and they are the parents to two sons, Jeffery Nelson (deceased), and Sean Louis.

BLACK HISTORY TIDBIT

As we continue to celebrate the extraordinary life of Congressman Lewis, who died July 17, 2020 at 80 years old, we remember the history of "Bloody Sunday" – the courageous march that he led across the Edmund Pettus Bridge in Selma, Alabama, in 1965 – and the savage beating he and other activists endured there for the right to vote. The movement led to the passage of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, which is widely recognized as the most effective civil rights legislation ever passed. **Vote!!**
