

## Set up ePortfolio Website Using WordPress

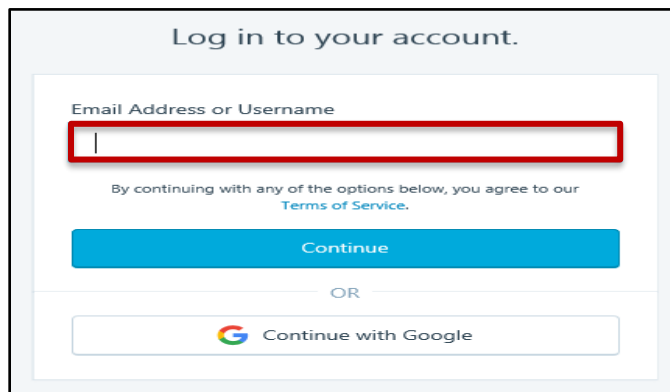
### PART 2: Import Montgomery College WordPress Template

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT:** Complete PART 1 instructions FIRST before starting PART 2. Using Firefox web browser to download the Montgomery College WordPress Template

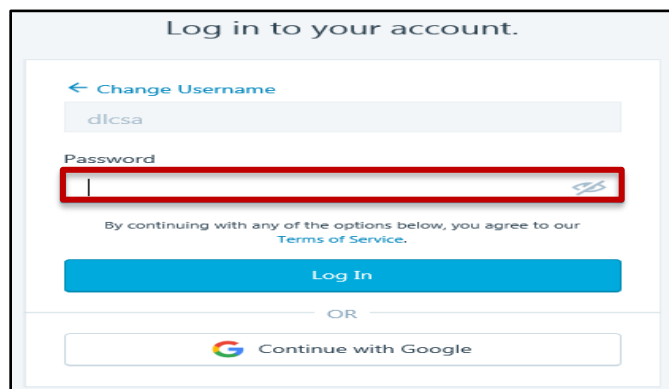
#### 1. Must Activate WordPress Account

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT:** Confirm your email address with WordPress first

- Log into your Montgomery College email and look for the email that WordPress sent you in order to activate your WordPress account
- Open the email from WordPress to confirm your email address

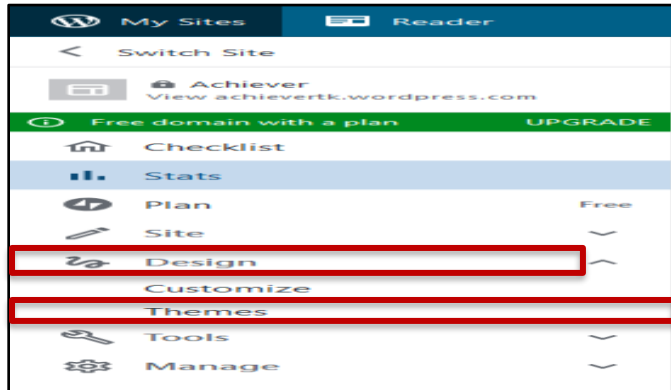


- **NEXT**
- Type in your **Montgomery College email address** or **Username** to log in your WordPress account
- Click on the button **Continue**

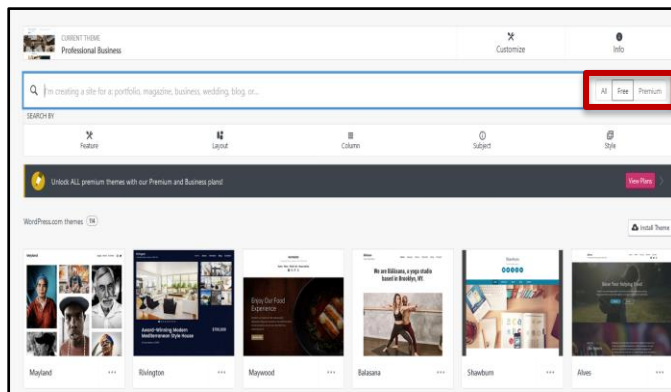


- **NEXT**
- Type in your **Password**
- Click on the button **Log In**

## 2. Set Your WordPress Theme



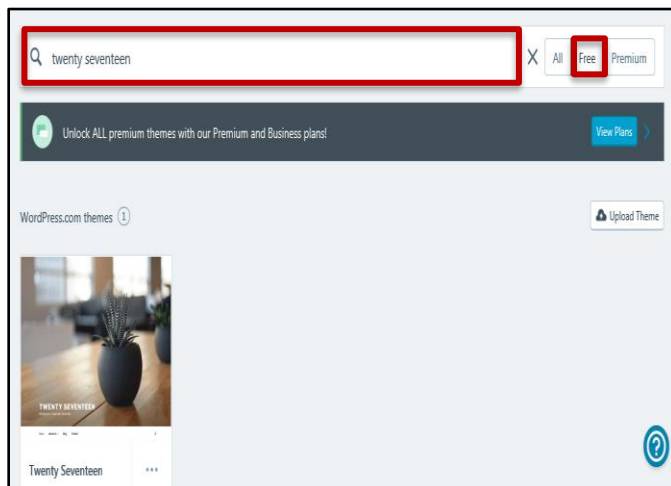
- **NEXT**
- On the left area of your website (Menu Customization Options), click on the down arrow **Design** to select **Themes**



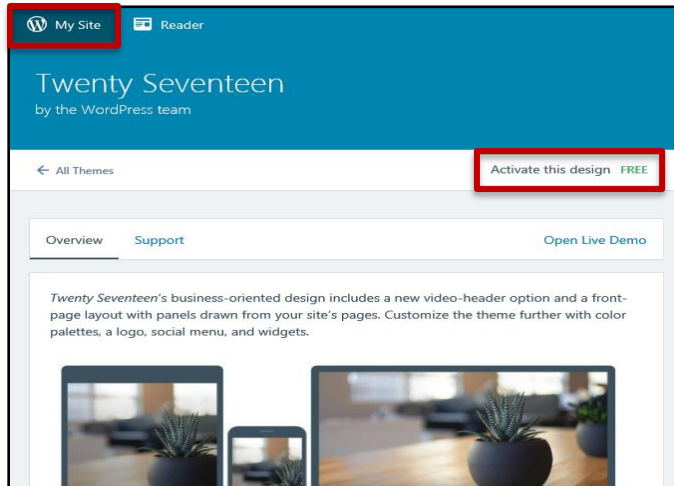
- **NEXT**
- Once Themes are displayed, click on the middle button **Free** (It's located on the right of the box SEARCH BY)

### IMPORTANT

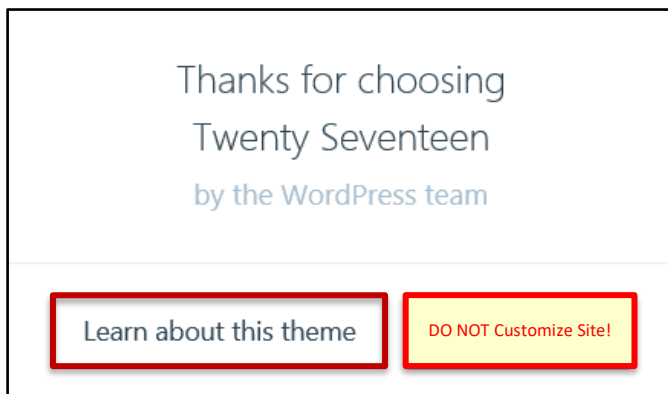
- Montgomery College recommends you to select theme **Twenty Seventeen** which is used to import Montgomery College WordPress Template



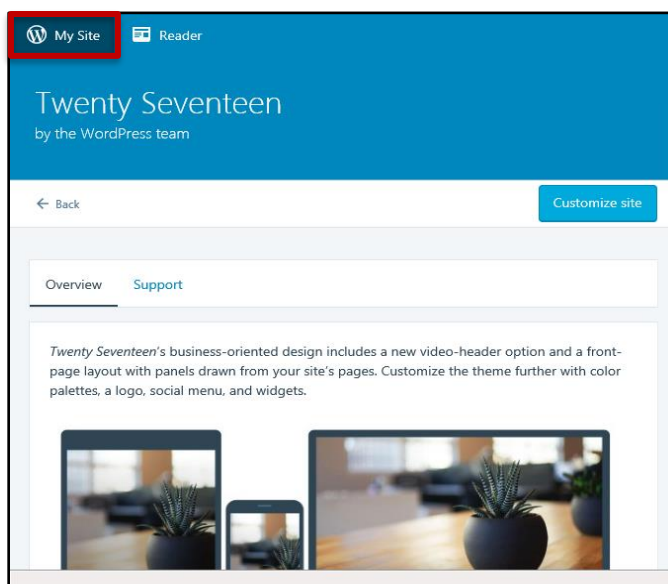
- **NEXT**
- In the SEARCH box, type in **twenty seventeen**. Then, the theme **Twenty Seventeen** which is the image "Aloe Pot" appears in the search
- Click on the image **Aloe Pot** to be the theme for your website



- **NEXT**
- Once theme **Twenty Seventeen** is selected, click on the button **Activate this design FREE**



- **NEXT**
- DO NOT click on the button Customize Site!
- You will see the message **Thanks for Choosing Twenty Seventeen**
- Click on the button **Learn about this theme**

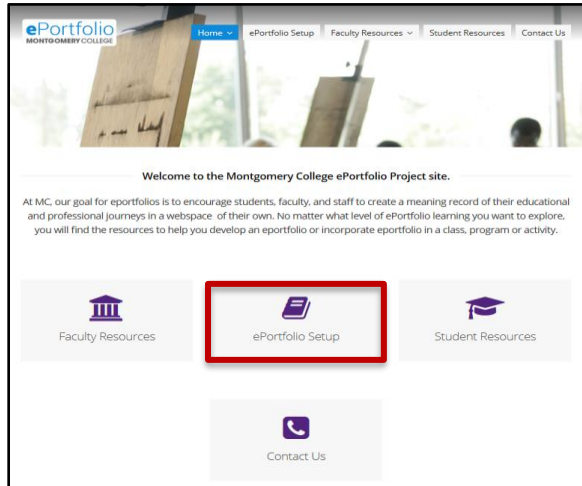


- **NEXT**
- Once the theme **Twenty Seventeen** is activated, click on the link **My Site** (It's on the top left of your site)
- **STOP HERE!**
- DO NOT close your website!

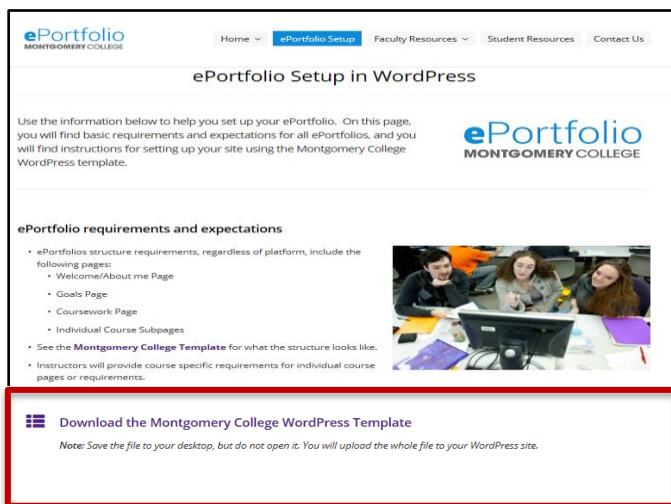
### 3. Download the Montgomery College WordPress Template

#### IMPORTANT

First, you will need to download the **Montgomery College WordPress Template** before you will import the template into your website



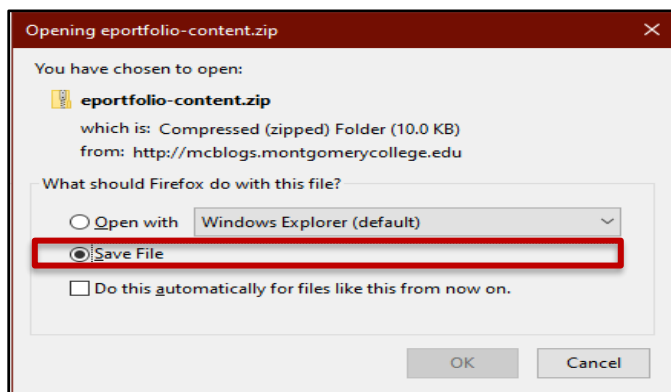
- At the web browser, type in <http://mcblogs.montgomerycollege.edu/eportfolio/>
- At the **Montgomery College ePortfolio** homepage, click on the middle menu icon **ePortfolio Setup**



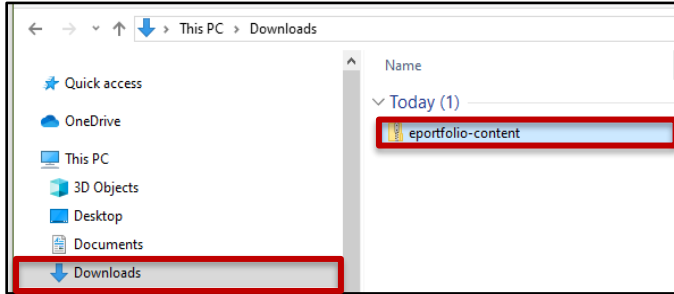
- **NEXT**
- At the **ePortfolio Setup in WordPress** page, scroll down at the bottom of the page. Then, click on **Download the Montgomery College WordPress Template**
- **DO NOT** open the file "[eportfolio-content.zip \(10.0 KB\)](#)"

#### IMPORTANT

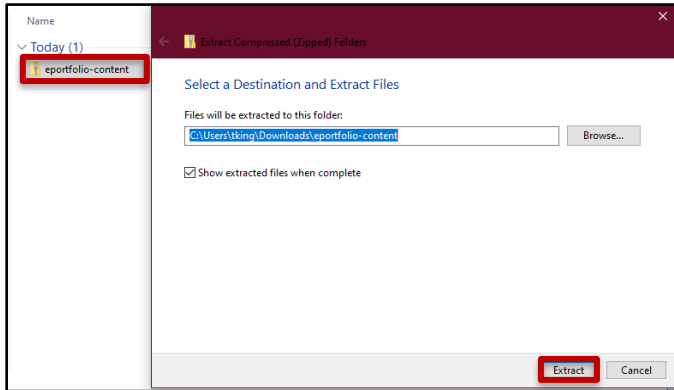
Without extracting the zip file (**eportfolio-content.zip**), you cannot import the Montgomery College WordPress Template Content



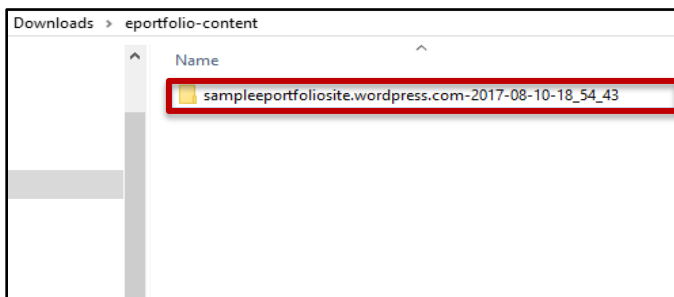
- **NEXT**
- Click on the button **Save file**. Then, click on **OK**



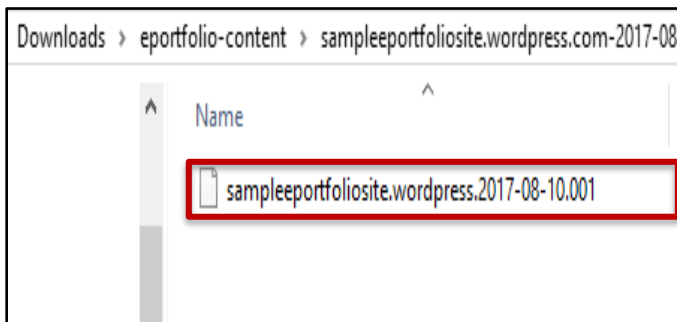
- **NEXT**
- By default, web browser settings, the file **eportfolio-content.zip** is saved in the **Downloads** folder



- **NEXT**
  - Right click on the file **eportfolio-content.zip** in the **Downloads** folder. Then, select the option **Extract All**
  - Click on the button **Extract**
- The extracted file (**sampleportfoliosite.wordpress-2017-08-10-18-54-43**) will be saved in the **Downloads** folder



- **NEXT**
- Double-click on the file **sampleportfoliosite.wordpress-2017-08-10-18-54-43**

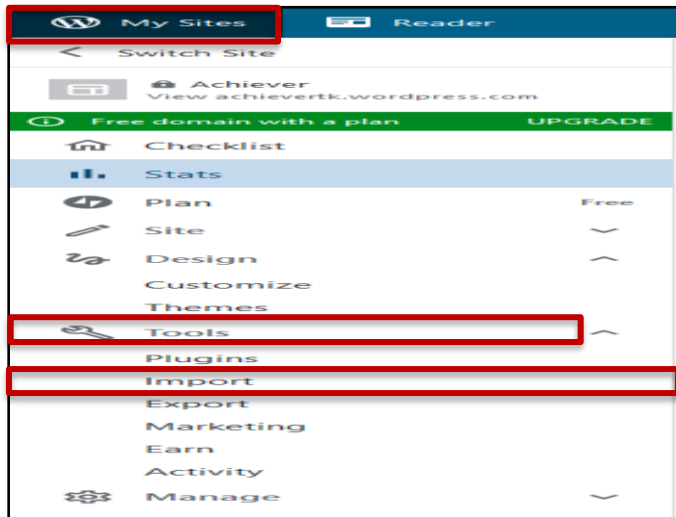


- **NEXT**
- The extracted file **“sampleportfoliosite.wordpress-2017-08-10.001.xml”** will be imported into your website
- DO NOT open the file **“sampleportfoliosite.wordpress-2017-08-10.001.xml”**
- DO NOT close the **Downloads** folder
- **STOP HERE!**

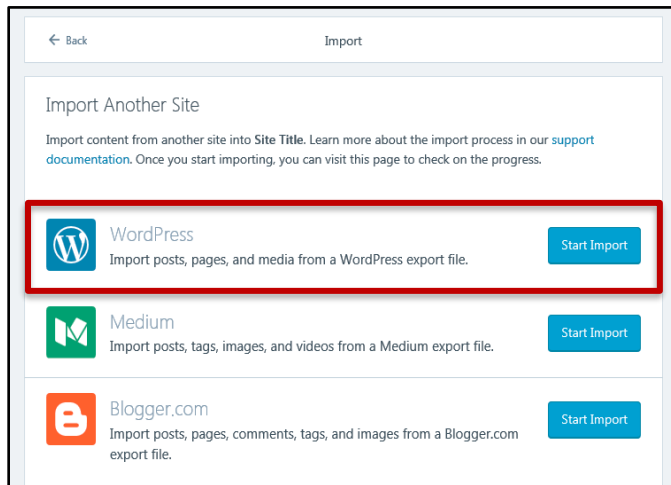
## 4. Import Montgomery College WordPress Template

### IMPORTANT

You will need to import the extracted file ([sampleportfoliosite.wordpress-2017-08-10.001.xml](#)) into your website



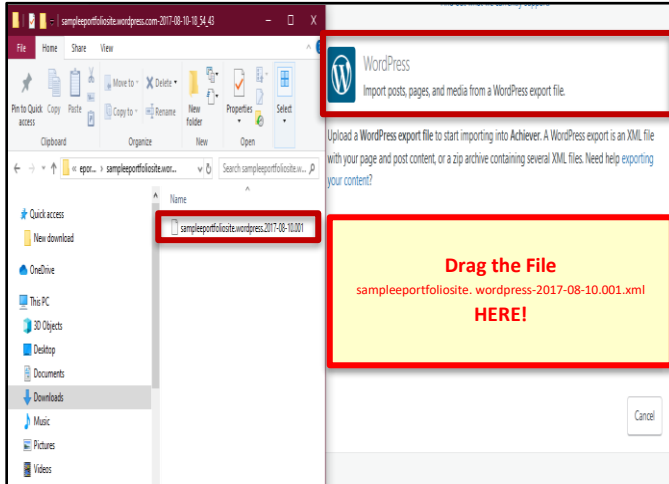
- **NEXT**
- At your website, click on the link **My Site** (It's on the top left of your website)
- On the left area of your website (Menu Customization Options), click on the down arrow **Tools** and select **Import** (It's the second option under Tools)



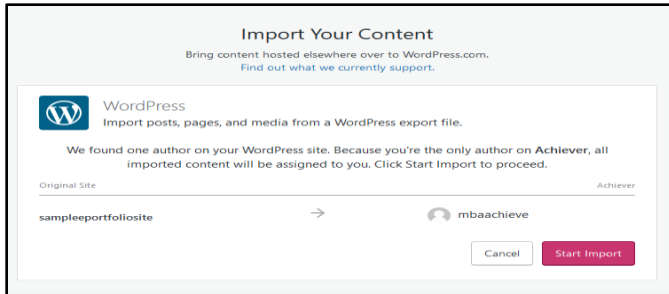
- **NEXT**
- At the Import area, click on the button **Start Import** (its' located inside **WordPress**) (Import posts, pages, and media from a WordPress export file)

### IMPORTANT

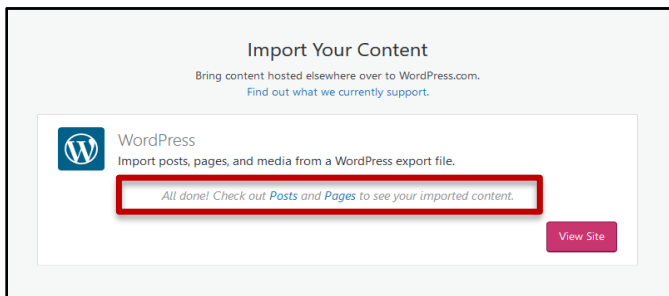
The extracted file ([sampleportfoliosite.wordpress-2017-08-10.001.xml](#)) that is **STILL** located in the **Downloads** folder



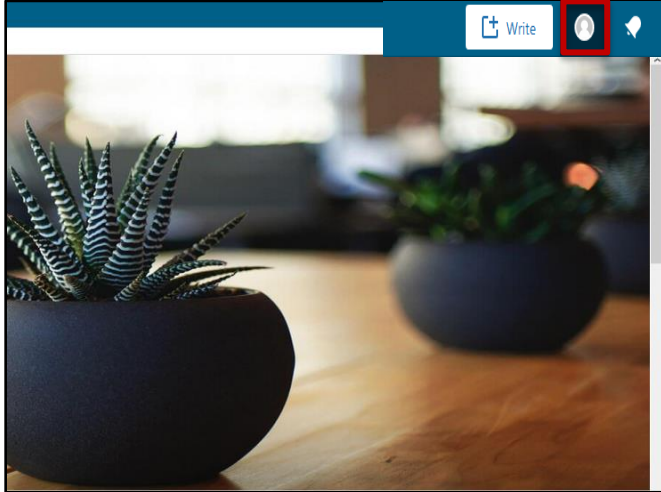
- **NEXT**
- Drag the extracted file (**sampleportfoliosite.wordpress-2017-08-10.001.xml**) located in the **Downloads** folder
- Drop the file into WordPress designed area (Drag a file here, or click to upload a file)



- **NEXT**
- Click on the button **Start Import**



- **NEXT**
- Once the extracted file (sampleportfoliosite.wordpress-2017-08-10.001.xml) is imported successfully. All done!
- Click on the button **View Site**



- **NEXT**
  - Now, you need to log out your website
  - Click on the **Person** icon (It's on the left of the Bell icon top right corner of your site) to log out your site,
  - **STOP HERE!**
- IMPORTANT**
- You will need to log into your email to look for the email that WordPress sent you in order to confirm your WordPress import ([Your WordPress import was successful](#))
