### Set up the Outlook mobile app on an Android device

You can set up the Outlook mobile app on your Android device to access your email, calendar, and contacts. The instructions below will show you how to set up your Office 365 Exchange Online mailbox on your mobile device.

- 1. On your Android phone or tablet, go to the **Google Play Store** and type **Microsoft Outlook** in the search box. You can also use the **Google Play Store** search widget to search for the app.
- 2. In the search results, select the Microsoft Outlook app, and then select Install.



3. Select Accept to accept the access agreement.







4. When the installation is complete, select **Open**.



5. When the app opens, select Get Started.



6. On the Add Account screen, enter your UN email address and select Continue.



7. Enter your Unite Identity password and select Sign in.





8. Review the screens about the Focused Inbox, Calendar and Attach Files features.

That's it. You're done!
