

Message from Rev. Hollie



It's been a tough winter. While the last couple weeks have been relatively decent, my mind strongly remembers the bitter cold we experienced the first month of 2018. On February 2, Punxsutawney Phil saw his shadow, a near-scientific indication we will experience 6 more weeks of winter. Further, we've only experienced 16 days of sun in the last 60 days! Without a doubt the weather has helped set the the scene for our Lenten wilderness experience. I've been in the wilderness of my house - too wet to go outside, too cold to move, experiencing the antithesis of the wilderness but with all the experiences: stuck with the aloneness of my thoughts.

It is easy to get caught up in the negative, getting bogged down with what we don't have or isn't happening. Then every once in a while something stirs us along the journey to hope. The other day while walking into the church, I experienced that stirring. I saw daffodils blooming! I squealed with excitement! A hint of Spring! A hint of warmth! A hint of color against the gray sky. As I looked around I realized there were lots of signs of hope - tiny blooms on plants and pink buds on the trees!

There are signs of life all around us. We just have to tune our eyes into seeing them!
