From the President

My two years as President of the Shaker Schools Foundation have reminded me of the factors that make Shaker Heights a remarkable place to live: ours is a caring and generous community that values its public school system; the Shaker Heights City Schools offer an exceptional education to every child who is enrolled; our teachers, administrators, and staff are a dedicated group of talented individuals; our students are capable of greatness.



Furthermore, the 32-year-old Shaker Schools Foundation is an extraordinary resource for our schools and our community. I have enjoyed working with our trustees, who so generously share their time, intelligence, and contributions to ensure that the Foundation upholds its mission to enrich the educational experiences of Shaker's students.

I am pleased to report that the Foundation continues to grow in stature and capacity. Our Strategic Plan provides guidance, our Board provides leadership, and our loyal donors provide the means to fulfill our mission. We experienced growth during the 2013 fiscal year, and our independent audit was clean. The Annual Fund exceeded \$123,000, and we contained our operating expenses and ended with a surplus for the fourth consecutive year. From July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013, we focused on four broad goals: raise permanent, unrestricted endowment; increase the number of alumni donors; increase the Foundation's visibility in the community; and increase the number of donors in Northeast Ohio. Elsewhere in this Annual Report you will read the details of our activities.

A Shaker education gives each child an uncommonly broad experience in the arts, sciences, athletics, social sciences, and citizenship. Our schools provide a supportive atmosphere of academic rigor and an opportunity for students to excel across numerous trajectories. Shaker's dynamic teaching staff produces critical thinkers and young adults who confidently engage in their communities, no matter where they choose to go in this competitive world. Our goal is to make each child's education richer through the work of the Shaker Schools Foundation, securing the strength of our community for future generations.

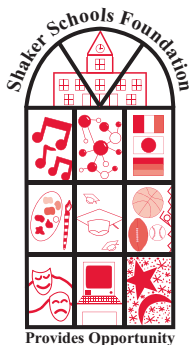

During fiscal year 2013, the Foundation was involved in a number of activities in support of its mission to *provide resources to enrich the educational experience of students of the Shaker Heights City School District*. And, we upheld our Strategic Plan by continuing to attract permanent unrestricted endowment, increasing the Foundation's visibility in the community, serving our alumni, and encouraging a growing number of Northeast Ohioans to donate.

- A special event on October 2, 2012, *An Evening with David Pogue*, supported the Legacy Fund. Legacy Society members were invited at no charge to this ticketed presentation, and they also attended a post-event reception with Mr. Pogue.
- As part of the Centennial of the City of Shaker Heights, the Foundation hosted Dr. Michael Roizen on October 16, 2012 in a program that was free and open to the public.
- The Foundation introduced an online donation option in November 2012.
- On March 5, 2013, the Foundation hosted a special percussion concert that featured Shaker graduates, Luke Rinderknecht and Dinesh Joseph, and two other professional musicians. Proceeds from the evening added \$3,400 to the Charlotte Braverman Music Enrichment Fund.
- The Marketing Committee made arrangements to create a display at Van Aken Shopping Center. Posters about the Foundation's activities, including our Corporate Sponsors, were in place from April through mid-June of 2013.
- Also as part of the Centennial celebrations for the city and school district, the Foundation partnered with the Band Boosters to help fund a commission by P. A. Sparke, which received its premiere in December 2012.
- Projects supported by the Class of 1950/January 51 continue to be implemented. They include teacher creativity grants; fee subsidies for an on-site Princeton Review course for the PSAT, ACT, and SAT; and a six-week Summer Academy to help 25 incoming 9th graders have a good chance for success at the High School. A second, three-week Summer Academy was offered in summer 2013 to the students who attended in 2012.
- The Foundation partnered with the District to upgrade the projector and software in the planetarium. Our share of the expenses was \$135,000.
- In honor of Superintendent Mark Freeman, the Foundation was pleased to co-host a community-wide reception on May 28, 2013.

Enrichment Grants

Annual proceeds from many of the Shaker Schools Foundation’s endowed funds support teacher grants that enrich the education of Shaker’s students. During the 2013 fiscal year, the Foundation distributed \$8,766 in 21 enrichment grants to 31 teachers. Sample grants in elementary, middle, and high school buildings provided:

- Support of basic skills among Kindergarteners and their families at Fernway, Lomond, and Mercer elementary schools;
- Materials for musical and artistic pursuits in the K-4 buildings;
- Stability balls to allow students at Woodbury to move quietly while working (pictured above);
- Support for team building activities at Shaker Middle School;
- Expansion of the Learning Garden at Shaker Heights High School.

The Foundation also provided \$136,343 in additional funds to support special projects such as master classes for voices and strings at the High School; assistance with expenses for students to participate in the band and orchestra trips to Turkey and China, respectively; and the purchase of a new scoreboard for the baseball team. For the MAC Scholars Program, the Foundation raised \$5,000 from the Harry K. Fox and Emma R. Fox Foundation and \$2,500 from Key Foundation. The Foundation also helped raise \$30,000 from the Martha Holden Jennings Foundation to support implementation of the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme.

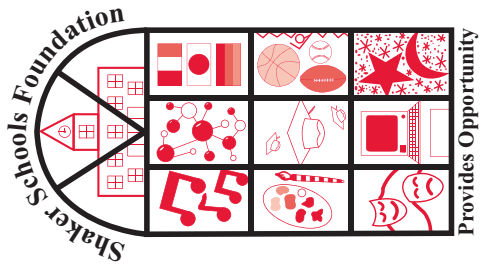
