Retreat to Re-energize and Serve

Catholic Charities' agency directors and pastoral ministry staff recently gathered for their annual 24-hour retreat at Olmstead Manor in Ludlow, Pa. Led by Father Mike DeMartinis, the group spent quality time together in prayer, discussion and service.

This year, the leadership

team prepared 18 large pans of lasagna which were given to local community housing residents and shut-ins in nearby Kane, Pa. As part of their retreat experience, the participants shopped together for ingredients at the local supermarket, then peeled, chopped, cooked and assembled the hearty meals. Under the leadership of Father Phil Pinczewski, former pastor of St. Callistus Parish in Kane, delivery was arranged and coordinated with the help of several parish volunteers.

"The efforts of these leaders reminded all of us of the importance of every effort that is made to lessen the burden of the poor," said Ann Badach, executive director of Catholic Charities. "With so many cooks in the kitchen you'd think there would have been chaos, but instead, what we experienced was the joy that comes from being generous, and a chance to share in the experience of hands-on service."

Directors representing five agencies and five rural and pastoral ministries from across the Diocese of Erie were represented at this year's retreat.
