Auditions & Call Backs: This show will be competitively cast. The auditions will take place on Monday, July 29 & Tuesday, July 30 at 6:30 p.m. We may decide callbacks are needed. You will be contacted by one of the directors if you are needed for a callback.

Cast List: Will be posted on the Shelby County Community Theatre's website: <http://www.shelbytheatre.org/> by Thursday, August 1. If you provide a LEGIBLE e-mail address, the cast list will be sent to you as well.

Rehearsals: Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. and Saturdays from 1 – 3 p.m. at Shelby County Community Theatre. There will be a brief mandatory Family Meeting on Saturday, August 3 at 12:30 p.m. with our first rehearsal following at 1:00 p.m.

Rehearsal Expectations: Actors must be dropped off and picked up from the theatre **ON TIME**. They should be prepared with their script, a pencil, a water bottle, snack, and appropriate footwear (no flip flops).

Tech & Dress Rehearsals: Monday September 9, Tuesday September 10, and Wednesday September 11 from 6:30 – 9:30 p.m. **Actors must attend all of these rehearsals!**

Performances: September 12, 13, 14, 18, 19, 20, 21 at 7:30 p.m. September 15 and 22 at 2:30 p.m. **(All are expected to stay after on the 22nd for Strike and Cast Party.)**
