

AWARDS PROCESS:

- 1. The Northeastern Region Awards Manual is updated annually; <u>please make sure that you have the most up to date manual before proceeding.</u> Carefully read the Required Documentation for awards.
- 2. An application is required for all awards.
- 3. The deadline for submission of applications is March 24th, 11:00 PM.
- 4. All required documentation <u>must be submitted with applications by the designated deadline</u> in order for the submission to be considered eligible for judging.
- 5. The applicant is accountable for making sure all required documentation is submitted. The achievement and awards committee will not notify chapters or individuals if documentation is missing.
- 6. Chapters submitting incomplete applications for the Hattie Redford intent to exhibit will not be eligible to a display at the regional conference. Chapters will be notified of disqualification.

- 7. Mail submissions are to be received in hand by March 24th. Mail tracking is encouraged for your concern. If there is a delay in the mailing system, written notice must be given to the awards co-chair prior to the close of March 24th.



RULES FOR ANNIE W. NEVILLE TALENT COMPETITION - Boule Year

This competition is limited to undergraduate Sorors. The Undergraduate chapter coordinator must receive the "Intent to Enter" form by March 24th.

Contestants must limit their performance to three (3) minutes

- 1. Five (5) points will be deducted for each minute the performer goes over the three minutes.
- 2. Time will be counted once the contestant begins her performance (e. g., starts singing, and moves to dance).
- 3. If a prop does not activate properly (such as a light or tape recorder), the contestant <u>must not move</u> but must motion the person she has designated to correct it. Points will <u>not be deducted</u> however; each contestant only has one opportunity for this to occur.
- 4. The Achievement and Awards Committee shall designate a time keeper to operate a clock for each contestant. Questions of the length of the presentation shall be decided by the time keeper.
- 5. There will be at least three judges. One judge shall be the 2nd grand Anti-Basileus OR the Northeastern Region's youth services coordinator. One judge shall be the undergraduate chapter coordinator. The remaining judge shall be a representative from the NE Region's Achievement and Awards Committee (this judge must NOT have a contestant from an undergraduate chapter that her graduate chapter sponsors.) The Achievement and Awards Committee may exercise its discretion to substitute judges in the event of an absence or emergency for the designated judges.
- 6. Contestants are responsible for bringing their own music and any other props needed with them to the competition. A piano request must be indicated on the Intent to Enter Form. The host chapter of the Regional Conference will be notified of this request.

Regional Protocol for Chapter Displays

The Hattie Redford Award is given to an alumnae and an undergraduate chapter <u>that best exhibits</u> the chapter achievements. In an off*Boule year activities are judged from *regional conference to regional conference*. In a Boule year, the activities exhibited are from Boule to Boule.

- 1. Chapters entering an exhibit must submit a Northeastern Region Chapter Report Form by March 24th to the Northeastern region Syntaktes and follow the application instructions.
- 2. Chapters entering an exhibit must be in good financial standing with the region.
- 3. Undergraduate chapters shall be judged on chapter report, scrapbook, and exhibits (craftwork, etc.).
- 4. Graduate chapters shall be judged on chapter report and scrapbook.
- 5. The scrapbook and craftwork shall be judged as separate exhibits.
- 6. Presentation of display should include color, arrangement, comprehensiveness, continuity, neatness, and project the national theme.
- 7. Points for judging exhibit include originality, neatness, variety, creativity, and artistic ability.
- 8. Points for judging scrapbook: current news clippings, chapter achievements (from Boule to Boule in the year of a Boule), neatness, variety of activities, originality, continuity of theme.
- 9. Scrapbooks on display should have the following organization:
 - Identification of the Chapter on the cover of the book
 - * Table of contents
 - Chapter Officer Roster
 - Chapter Membership Roster
 - Northeastern Region Chapter Report
 - Chapter Calendar
 - Chapter Activities (either organized by type, national programs, Founder's Day etc. or by chronology)
- 10. Pictures of chapter activities should be identifiable by names and dates.
- 11. Programs of chapter activities should be dated.
- 12. Outside organizations' documentation should be on the organization's letterhead.
- 13. Chapter exhibits will be eliminated from award consideration for including:
 - ❖ Any official sorority book (e.g., <u>Aurora</u>)
 - Complete magazines
 - Materials classified for official business
 - Substituting an affiliates scrapbook
- 14. The alumnae chapter and undergraduate chapter biennial regional winners will represent the region at Boule and compete in the National Hattie Redford Award competition. Exhibits competing at Boule must be updated to include activities from Boule to Boule.


