1909 15,000 women march through New York City demanding shorter work hours, better pay and voting rights.

1911 The inaugural International Women's Day held and over one million women and men rally the cause.

1975 Designated as 'International Women's Year' by the United Nations.

2000+ Afghanistan, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Burkina Faso, Cambodia, China, Cuba, Georgia, Guinea-Bissau, Eritrea, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Madagascar, Maldives, Mongolia, Mozambique, Nepal, Russia, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Vietnam and Zambia celebrate International Women's Day as an official holiday.

Annually, on March 8, thousands of events are held throughout the world to inspire women and celebrate achievements. A global web of rich and diverse local activity connects women from all around the world: political rallies, business conferences, government activities, networking events, local craft markets, theater performances, parades and in our case, a global dialogue.
