GARY EDDY (N) 28 188 85 - Rangy full-forward, full-back or ruckman.

TONY GEPP (S) 20 182 76 - Rugged backman with good pair of hands. Has represented SA Country.

DAVID HUNT (N) 24 188 76 - Rangy key position player. Will probably settle at centre half forward. Has represented SA Country.

RANDALL HERN (W) 19 182 70 - Very promising young Centreman.

KERRY HOSKINS (N) 29 189 106 - Big strong "mountain man" ruckman.

KERRY JAY (W) 25 192 76 - Aptly named "Spider". tall mobile ruckman.

PETER JOHNS (S) 30 189 85 - Middleton Medallist. Has represented SA Country. Full-forward.

PHIL KILLEEN (S) 24 176 70 - Fast-moving run-on player.

IAN MCKAY (S) 25 182 70 - Ruckman and backman. Spectacular leaper on his day.

BRETT MORRIS (C) 27 182 70 - Swift moving and versatile utility.

MARK QUINLIVAN 19 180 72 - MCU Quiet achiever. Close checking high leaping defender. New to the representative scene.

BRETT VERING 26 188 90 - Captain Coach of Barellan United, current undefeated leaders in FFL. Solid defender, strong mark, long kick.

MARK HOFERT 26 184 87 - North Wagga. Probably the teams most versatile player. Has represented Sydney, RFL And Farrer as well and playing for NSW.

JAMIE DURHAM 25 180 78 - Temora. Has developed into a top defender. First rep. game.

ROSS MCKENZIE 26 185 85 - Temora. Utility player who does not shirk as issue. In top form with Temora after a year in the RFL.

PAUL IRVINE 19 183 76 - Ardlethan. Centreman with Club side, but likely to play in defence. Representative player last year.

ANDREW CORBETT 24 188 80 - Ardlethan Captain Coach. Recruited from the RFL which he represented in 1986-87. Fine mark excellent long kick.

CHRIS CONLAN 22 183 75 - Barellan United. Top rover in the league tireless player with speed and class.

DAVID CURRIE 18 183 73 - Ardlethan. Youngster with good potential. Centreman or ruck rover. Runner-up in Farrer League best and fairest last year.

GARY CROUCH 25 175 68 - North Wagga. Rover whose fine performances have been rewarded with League representation.

STEVEN HENLEY (C) 29 182 80 - Captain-Coach MCU Club, who he coached to premiership last year. Centreman who is "unbeatable" on his day.

KEVIN "DICK" CAREY (VC) 27 193 94- Captain-Coach North Wagga. Played for Wagga and represented RFL last year. Capable in defence or attack. A "prodigal" returned from SA.

MARK HODGSON 26 194 98 - Barellan United ruckman. Strong in the air and very mobile for a big fellow. Versatile player who could play well in a key position.

DON OLIVER 30 186 90 - Captain-Coach Cootamundra. Can play equally well in defence or attack. An experienced footballer who has represented all leagues with whom he has played. A former ACT representative and captain of NSW State team.

IAN LUCAS 26 180 84 - Barellan United. Ruck-rover who runs all day. A regular representative player.

RICHIE ROBINSON 24 193 80 - Captain-coach Marrer. Tall ruckman who's a regular representative player having been in Farrer League side last year and the Riverina Football League side in 1987 for the past two State Championships.

STEPHEN COLE 28 182 75 - MCU High flying forward with great goal sense. Is a regular League representative and has played for NSW.

JOHN SCHULTZ 24 186 85 - MCU Hard-hitting and dashing half-back. Usually gives away centimetres to his opponent but is rarely beaten. Regular Farrer League rep.

ANDREW BUCKHORN 23 187 75 - Centre of clearance wrangle and consequently has not played this season. Nevertheless fine efforts in past seasons for Farrer, in defence, warrant his selection.
