<u>Grantee Corner</u>

Thomas V. Guarino Academic Medical Award Recipient

The Thomas V. Guarino Family Academic Medicine and Research Fund was created to reflect the new educational needs of medical students, medical residents, and fellows of Orange Regional Medical Center just after the opening of a local medical school and the hospital's graduate medical program. While there were many needs identified, fulfilling basic requests for funding for research and conference attendance were primary. This donor-designated fund is designed to fund such requests.

The purpose of the Virtual Reality Neurofeedback Pain (VR NFB) study is to evaluate the efficacy of the novel technology and its role in chronic pain management. Patients play video games while their brainwave activity is recorded using the EEG. The purpose of the games is to train, coach, and rewire the patient's brain, and to activate their brain's selfrepairing mechanisms. The idea is that if the brain is trained consistently at targeted areas at certain frequencies individualized for the patient, they will eventually be more resilient and self-regulating, and see improvements in their pain. Patients might also experience improvements in pain-related anxiety, depression, sleep deprivation, and activities of daily living (ADLs).

One clinical trial patient suffered from back pain from herniated disks, severe spasms, and pain shooting down his leg. His initial pain score was eight out of 10 and presented to the clinic as depressed, tearful, and anxious. After one month of eight out of 20 total clinical trial sessions, he discontinued nightly Hydrocodone, Cyclobenzaprine, Benzodiazepine, and Naproxen, became independent of his back brace, and reported a 60 percent improvement in pain and mobility. He also reported an improvement in his mood, sleep, and ADLs. One patient who suffered cervical spine

damage after a motor vehicle accident presented with PTSD associated with the crash, depression, sleep deprivation, and problems with ADLs. She started the VR NFB Pain study with a pain score of nine out of 10, with pain shooting down her right arm to her fingers, spasms, and decreased range of motion. After 20 sessions, she discontinued Cyclobenzaprine and Meloxicam, and had a 40 percent decrease in pain. She also reported a 65 percent improvement in pain at her 4-month follow up. Her activities of daily living (ADLs) improved by 40 percent, while her independent activities of daily living (IADLs) improved by 50 percent and her sleep improved by 20 percent.

"Dr. Orakpo's study gave me my life back. It enabled me to regain my sanity, alleviated a very dark depression, and allowed me to laugh again. It has been a very long haul, and I am not quite in the clear yet," the patient said. "This study is an integral cog to a vast pain management plan. I do believe that without Dr. Orakpo's VR Pain study I would have had a very different dark story to tell."

As the clinical trial continues, it seems that as of now, the treatment improves self-regulation and helps decrease the patient's dependence on medications that have potential for abuse and addiction. The impact on the daily lives of the patients is evident and appears to continue to improve even after they have finished their 20 sessions. We have seen VR alone be effective for acute pain, but when combined with EEG Neurofeedback therapy, and the brain is trained to produce healthier rhythms, the effects seem permanent.

The VR Pain Suite is in the POB 4th floor, Suite 16 and operates Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 5 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Sessions are 30 minutes each; two sessions per week are recommended until the patient completes 20 sessions


