It includes the three hospitals that make up Southcoast Hospitals Group — Charlton Memorial Hospital in Fall River, St. Luke's Hospital in New Bedford and Tobey Hospital in Wareham; and Southcoast Behavioral Health in Dartmouth, a joint venture with Acadia Healthcare, an international leader in psychiatric and addiction care.

Southcoast provides advanced clinical services, such as open heart surgery, angioplasty and heart rhythm services, comprehensive cancer care, neurosurgery, weight loss surgery, orthopedic surgery, advanced imaging services and is the only provider of maternity services in the region.

Southcoast is a not-for-profit charitable organization that depends on the support of the community to provide services.

Overview:

Under the general direction of the Senior Vice President CIO for Southcoast Health System, the Chief Information Security Officer will perform a wide variety of duties including establishing, implementing, monitoring, and enforcing information security standards enterprise-wide. The CISO will be responsible for the creation and maintenance of enterprise-wide information security strategies. This position will oversee the creation and maintenance of information security policy, leads on-going security risk assessments and status reporting efforts and is responsible for the creation and roll-out of security awareness and training programs.

Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Computer Science, Business or related field; Master's Degree preferred
- Substantial and directly related information security skills and experience may substitute for some education
- Must have at least 7-10 years of IT related management experience in a complex healthcare environment
- Strong understanding of IT security threats and preventative measures, disaster management and techniques and technologies and IT related security laws, regulations and guidelines are required. Must work well with and in teams
- Advanced computer technical skills are required to understand the complex IT infrastructure in the enterprise
- Ability to lead through influence

Fairhaven, Massachusetts

Fairhaven, located halfway between Cape Cod and Providence, Rhode Island, has historical roots dating back from the American Revolution. Today, these historical remnants can be seen in its late 1800's European-style public buildings that add to the town's appeal. Fairhaven has a public state beach overlooking Buzzard's Bay, recreational marinas, specialty shops, and over 50

restaurants. 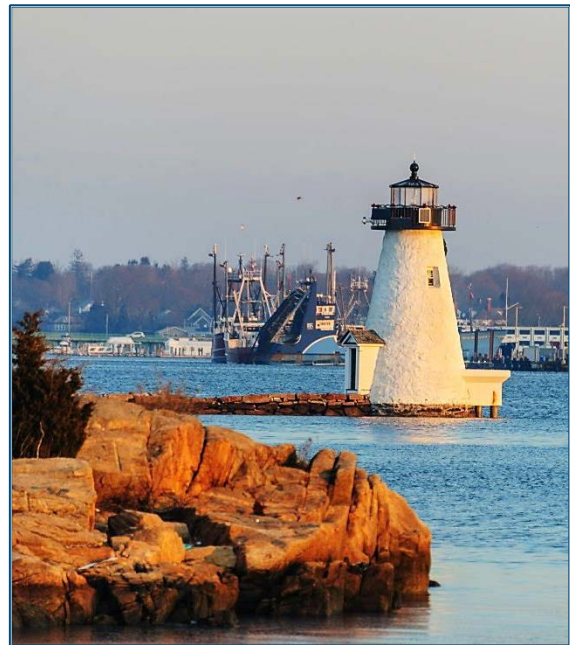

New Bedford was named “The 7th Most Artistic City in America ” by Atlantic Magazine, based on the ratio of city residents that are professional artists. Within the historic downtown’s cobblestoned streets, residents can walk to a large number of galleries and exhibits, as well cafes, antique shops, and museums.

The New Bedford Harbor has three boat launches on the Acushnet River, which flows south into Buzzards Bay and the Atlantic Ocean. The harbor is ideal for fishing, sailing, rowing, kayaking, and motor boating.

The city’s South End has three miles of accessible beaches and includes the Blue Lane, a set of recreational paths along the city’s hurricane barrier that offer spectacular views.

The North End has an International Marketplace, open year round, with multicultural shops, restaurants, and hosts numerous summer festivals.

Acushnet — Acushnet is a rural community at the mouth of the Acushnet River with a population of about 10,000 people. The town is a great place for families with country side living and good schools.

Dartmouth — This scenic coastal town, comprised of 64 square miles, is bordered by Buzzard’s Bay and is just west of New Bedford. Residential homes are nestled within a historic rural area with scenic forest lands. Dartmouth is home to The University of Massachusetts Dartmouth and has good schools.

Easton — This residential suburban community has an excellent school system and residents have access to over 4,000 acres of conservation land that include biking, hiking, and walking trails. Dighton — This small historic town along the Taunton River, is about a 30 minute commute to New Bedford. The area is great for families with an excellent school system and several parks and recreational fields.

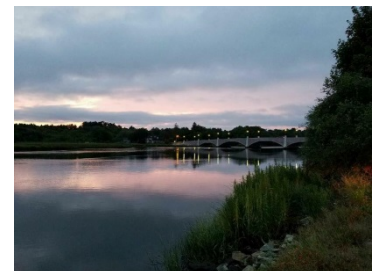
