Dear Friend,

In August 2013, I was alone with a gunman, in possession of an AK47 and over 500 rounds of ammunition. He was prepared to take his life along with the lives of children, teachers and faculty at the R. E. McNair Discovery Learning Academy where I was employed at the time. My story grabbed headlines across the world because of my ability to talk him down, potentially saving the lives of hundreds.

Since that incident, I have founded a non-profit organization called Kids on the Move for Success, Inc. In the past three years, our organization has awarded over 20 educational scholarships to students of all ages, both nationally and internationally. Many of these students are realizing their educational goals and attending college. We believe “If you can help them to develop a vision, you can change their lives!”

We are preparing to launch our Discovery sTEAM Mentoring Program for students in the Atlanta area. We will be hosting upcoming events to raise money so that we can help students in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (sTEAM). We will also impact through our launch at Canby Lane Elementary approximately 700 students in the sTEAM fields with group sessions and education field trips.

Antoinette Tuff is an inspirational woman who speaks with head, heart and energy about her love and personal relationship with God. Her faith and unwavering belief has allowed her to overcome struggles, worries and obstacles that were in her way. On August 20, 2013 her purpose was revealed!

Antoinette's extraordinary human drama of a school under siege, grabbed headlines around the world. "Everything I had done in my life up to this point, prepared me for this moment. Being alone with a gunman, his 500 rounds of ammunition and an angry promise to kill everyone, including himself, with his automatic weapon, an AK-47; seemed unbelievable." Antoinette's life hasn't been the same since talking the gunman into surrendering that day.

Antoinette has appeared with CNN's Anderson Cooper numerous times and was featured on CNN's Annual Heroes special.

Antoinette has met with global business and political leaders to tell her story and share her wisdom on how to use judgment in crisis and not just pass judgment in a heated moment. She also started our non-profit organization, Kids on the Move for Success, Inc.

Antoinette has been seen on Anderson Cooper 360, CNN, Good Morning America, The Steve Harvey Show, Nightly News with Diane Sawyer, The Arsenio Hall Show, The View and various other news outlets. The world has embraced Antoinette and deemed her to be their new hero!

Antoinette's courage and faith prevented tragedy in a school under siege. 870 children waited in fear as their elementary school rushed into lockdown mode. As the nation faced yet another Sandy Hook story of tragedy, one woman rewrote the ending.

The organization was developed to help underserved children all over the world see a new beginning and to know they too can push pass their life circumstances and be prepared for a purpose in life. ## MENTORING PROGRAM

### sTEAM Mentoring Program Overview

The Discovery sTEAM Mentoring Program will consist of traditional one-on-one mentoring partnerships that focus on sTEAM topics. Approximately 10 to 15 volunteer mentors from the community and the Atlanta area will be matched with student mentees from 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. The program will target underserved youth in the community, and the mentor/mentee matches will last through each academic year. Mentor/mentee matches will meet once per week during the student's lunch break or after school hours. Mentors are also expected to attend quarterly group events. We will also impact through our launch at Canby Lane Elementary approximately 700 students in the sTEAM fields with group sessions and education field trips.

### Mentoring Goals

KOTMFS hopes its mentoring program will increase student interest in sTEAM topics, improve academic performance, raise self-esteem and develop leadership skills.

### Pilot Program Outline

- This will be a traditional one-on-one mentoring partnership that focuses on sTEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math) topics.
- The pilot program will be held at Canby Lane Elementary School in Decatur, GA.
- The pilot program team will consist of KOTMFS staff, School Principal, Dr. Keshier M. Smikle, Assistant Principal, Kia Dennis, and STEM Liaison, Cecila Chavis. In addition, a parent liaison will be chosen.
- The program will target underserved youth in the community.
- We will have a minimum of 10-15 matches with mentors from the Atlanta area, the community and mentees from 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Mentor/Mentee matches will meet for 3 to 4 hours per month and attend quarterly group events. Matches will meet onsite at the school during lunch or after school. Offsite visits and/or meetings occur in-group sessions only.
- Some activities are sTEAM related, while others build self-esteem, leadership skills, relationships and trust between students and mentors. The mentor/mentee match will last the academic school year.

### Expected Outcomes

- Increased academic performance.
- Increase in self-esteem.
- Increase interest in science, technology, engineering, art and math (sTEAM) topics.
- Develop leadership skills

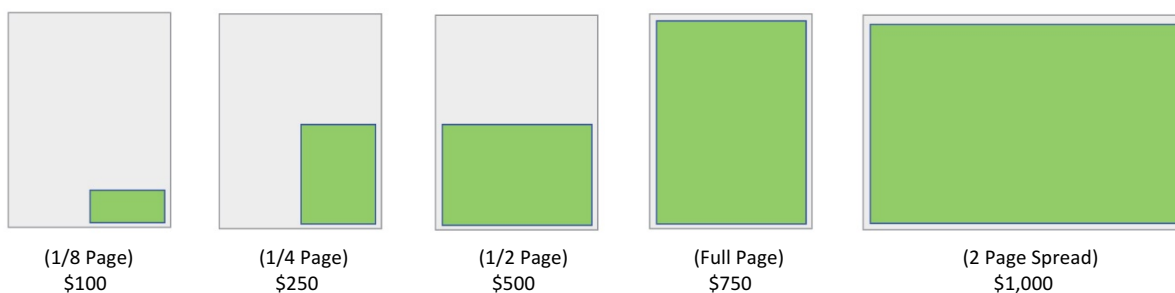
