

We purchased the latest in bassinet technology for The Hirair and Anna Hovnanian Foundation Regional Newborn Center, giving our smallest patients the best fighting chance for survival. These bassinets were desperately needed – over 5,000 babies were born at MMC last year, more babies than any other hospital in Monmouth or Ocean Counties. A newly purchased CAT scan was unveiled in the Cline-D'Onofrio Emergency Services Pavilion, allowing for expedited care of our most critically ill emergency room patients. Physicians now have the ability to see more anatomical detail in only a fraction of the time and view even the smallest arteries in the brain, heart and peripheral vascular system.

FRANK J. VOZOS, MD, FACS

A DISTINGUISHED LEADER

In 1998, Frank J. Vozos, M.D., FACS, became only the second physician in New Jersey to take on a top hospital leadership role when he assumed the position of executive director of Monmouth Medical Center, one of the state's largest teaching hospitals.

After nearly 20 years as Monmouth's chief executive, Dr. Vozos has been named to the position of executive vice president of Barnabas Health and chief executive of Monmouth Medical Center, Southern Campus.

"Dr. Vozos's vast experience as a surgeon and hospital chief executive will be essential to his new system role," Barnabas Health president and chief executive officer Barry Ostrowsky said in announcing the new position in December. "He will participate in clinical integration, strategy and growth of the system as Barnabas Health expands, and simultaneously oversee day-to-day operations at Monmouth Medical Center, Southern Campus."

On April 1, Dr. Vozos assumed his new role and turned over the reins of Monmouth Medical Center to his longtime chief operating officer, Bill Arnold.

"Bill's tenure at Monmouth mirrors mine as executive director—he joined the hospital in 1998 as administrative director of operations," Dr. Vozos said. "As chief operating officer since 2006, Bill has been recognized as a senior executive who has established himself as a leader in the development of strategic partnerships and a champion in the growth of both outpatient and emergency services."

Over the last 17 years, Dr. Vozos and Bill developed a unique rapport as leaders of Monmouth Medical Center. Together, they helped guide Monmouth to national and statewide distinction, including the Thompson Top 100 Performance Improvement Leaders Award.

"Personally, I want to thank Frank not only for being a tremendous leader, but for teaching me everything I know about the business of running a successful hospital," Bill said. "For the past 17 years, he has served as my teacher, mentor and confidante, but most importantly, my friend."

After growing up in western Pennsylvania and attending West Virginia University, Monmouth Medical Center president and chief executive officer Frank J. Vozos, M.D., FACS, first came to the hospital in 1975 to begin the five-year residency program in general surgery. He became a dedicated member of the greater Long Branch community – basing his entire professional career at Monmouth.

Dr. Vozos, a fellow of the American College of Surgeons and a diplomate of the American Board of Surgery who also served as a member of the New Jersey State Trauma Committee, served for 20 years as program director of the general surgery residency program at Monmouth and also served as president of the hospital's 900-member Medical and Dental Staff.

As Chief Executive Officer, Dr. Vozos has overseen a period of tremendous growth at Monmouth – both in terms of patient volume and services, as well as the merger with Kimball Medical Center, which is now Monmouth Medical Center Southern Campus.

Dr. Vozos serves the community as Chairman of the Board of Trustees for HealthSouth Rehabilitation Hospital of Tinton Falls, and as a board member of Monmouth-Ocean Hospital Service Corporation (MONOC), Jersey Shore Partnership and Prevention First of Monmouth County and the New Jersey Hospital Association's Policy Development Committee.

He has over the years been active in local service organizations such as Rotary, Lion's clubs and the Urban League. He notes a strong allegiance to the local police and fire departments and first aid squads, and points with pride to his appointment during the 1990s as a "police surgeon" in recognition of his support of the law enforcement community.

"It has been my tremendous honor to serve in the top leadership role at Monmouth Medical Center," he said. "Through my new role, I look forward to participating in clinical integration, strategy and growth as Barnabas Health expands and combines forces with Robert Wood Johnson Health System to create the state's largest health system and one of the largest in the nation."

Sheldon went to a walk-in clinic, where he was sent for an MRI. Frustrated after waiting five days for results and not hearing back from his doctor, he came to Monmouth Medical Center's Cline-D'Onofrio Emergency Services Pavilion and asked for help.

"The doctors and nurses were compassionate and understanding of my fears, and they were quick to provide a diagnosis, putting my mind at ease. I was told I would need surgery to repair my Achilles tendon and was introduced to orthopaedic surgeon, Dr. Marc Menkowitz. Dr. Menkowitz told me that he

could fix my Achilles and get me back on the court. That was all I wanted to hear! From the moment I arrived for my surgery, I knew I was at the right place. The staff treated me like I was their family, explaining every step of the way and provided Anne with updates to ease her mind." Both Anne and Sheldon have gone to other hospitals in the area over the years, but now consider MMC their hospital of choice. The Vogels have recently made a generous gift so that MMC can continue to provide excellent care to all patients!

Anne and Sheldon have a long history with Monmouth Medical Center and Long Branch. Anne's father Joseph Purcell was the Chief of Police for the City of Long Branch and her sister, Judy Ziegler, recently retired from MMC after 45 years of service. Sheldon's family owned and operated Vogel's Department Store.

Joe Torcivia, a Monmouth County resident and Monmouth Medical Center Foundation advisory board member, has an active and busy lifestyle. He is the co-president of Torcon, Inc., a construction management company based in Red Bank, NJ. He is an avid golfer and looks forward to his daily exercise regimen. Recently engaged to Lauren Hintlian, Joe has many plans for their new life together. Imagine his dismay when his chronic back pain no longer allowed for the activities that have been part of his routine for as long as he can remember, and altered his vision of what life would be to him and Lauren. "I was having trouble getting out of bed in the morning, couldn't travel or sit at my desk for too long and had to spend long periods of time flat on my back," said Joe.

Joe sought treatment from two different out of area doctors, and was not satisfied with the care he received. He was still left with no answers or relief and was becoming frustrated. Subsequently, he made an appointment with neurosurgeon, Dr. Ty Olson. Joe felt hopeful, as Dr. Olson was named in New Jersey Monthly's, Top Doctors for 2015, for the fourth consecutive year.

"Dr. Olson dedicated the time to my case to understand that my goal was to resume the activities I am no longer able to enjoy. Dr. Olson was able to quickly provide a diagnosis, and although frightening, offered a strategic care plan that would enable me to resume normal activities and live my life."

Joe had surgery on August 12, 2015 at Monmouth Medical Center, performed by Dr. Olson and Dr. Timothy Link. Today, six months post-surgery, he is back on the green, pain free! Joe and Lauren are now looking forward to a promising future and he is working to get his golf game to where it used to be, which naturally is "par" for the course.

On September 19, 2013, Patrick Kirwan was born unexpectedly at just 25 weeks and four days old at Monmouth Medical Center – he was only 2 lb. 2 oz. and 13 inches. Patrick was immediately transferred to The Hirair and Anna Hovnanian Foundation Regional Newborn Center (RNC) at Monmouth Medical Center. He could not yet breathe on his own and was fighting for his life.

For the next 141 days, the exceptional neonatologists, nurses and respiratory therapists at the RNC cared for Patrick through all his ups and downs, four surgeries and very unpredictable and difficult recoveries. The Kirwan family recalls every nurse and doctor operating with a family-centered approach, taking time each day to answer countless questions, providing in depth explanations of Patrick's conditions and even lending them a shoulder to cry on. The RNC staff gives each baby their best fighting chance to thrive, caring for

over 500 critically ill and premature babies in 2015 and boasting one of the state's highest infant survival rates.

The carefully selected clinical team became like a family to the Kirwans during that tumultuous time, forming a bond that they will never forget. The personalized and family-centered approach was invaluable, allowing the family to feel involved during a time when they felt nothing but true hopelessness. The Kirwans know that without the exceptional care they received at Monmouth Medical Center, there could have been the frightening possibility of a very different outcome due to Patrick's extremely premature birth and constant complications.

UNCONDITIONAL LOVE AND SUPPORT FROM PETS TO PATIENTS

The Freed Therapeutic Paws Program at Monmouth Medical Center is a huge success! The program has grown from five pet therapy teams to 20 pet therapy teams! Each team is made up of a hospital volunteer and his or her trained dog. Elizabeth Freed, President of the Freed Foundation, provided the funds for lectures, administrative support, promotional items, vaccinations and scholarships for the handlers.

Several years ago when the program started, MMC joined a research study investigation using our therapy dogs in radiology. The study found that for patients awaiting magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), interaction with a therapy dog proved soothing and helped decrease anxiety about the test. Radiology was a unique area for study because

patients of all ages, and with virtually every illness or injury, arrive for tests. The results were so convincing, MMC quickly expanded the program to other departments, making it one of the hospital's most popular programs.

The hospital's team of adult volunteers and their therapy animals provide a positive interaction each day that brings unconditional love and comfort from therapy animals to MMC patients. Handlers and therapy dogs are assigned to a specific unit, which develops camaraderie between the handler and staff. Thus, the pet therapy dog becomes part of the team. The teams spend most of their time in The Unterberg Children's Hospital visiting with pediatric inpatients. They also work with stroke patients, visit the medical/surgical oncology units, and the outpatient Pollak Mental Health Clinic.

leading the way in CANCER SUPPORT

The Cancer Support Community is an international non-profit organization with a mission to provide support for the physical and emotional concerns of individuals affected by cancer. From diagnosis, through treatment, recovery and survivorship, CSC provides members with support, education, hope and encouragement to be part of a community of others who are facing survivorship together.

In the fall of 2014, Monmouth Medical Center announced a partnership with the Cancer Support Community, thus becoming only the third hospital based program in the country. With programs running at both our Long Branch and Lakewood campuses, monthly groups include general and diagnosis specific support groups, educational workshops, strength building exercise classes, yoga, Qi-Gong, belly dancing, various opportunities for socialization and special lectures emphasizing wellness and the mind-body-spirit connection. All programs are offered free of charge to anyone affected by cancer including family members and support people, no matter where treatment is received.

The Cancer Support Community at Monmouth Medical Center and Monmouth Medical Center, Southern Campus, also work in collaboration with national organizations such as the American Cancer Society which host alternating monthly 'Look Good Feel Better' and 'Wig Program' workshops for women, The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, US TOO Prostate organization and SPOHNC (Oral/Head/Neck Support Group).

Opening the doors in February 2015 in Long Branch and in March 2015 in Lakewood, attendance has risen steadily over the past several months. The success of the program is attributed to continued review of feedback by members through program survey evaluations and quarterly focus group meetings. With over fifty groups and workshops currently running monthly and our active participation in many outreach community events both in Monmouth and Ocean counties, we look forward to continued growth in 2016!

More than 225 supporters joined The Unterberg Children's Hospital Leadership Council and Monmouth Medical Center Foundation to celebrate the second annual "A Toast to Children's Health" wine-tasting event, benefiting nearly 22,000 pediatric patients from the community who are treated at The Unterberg Children's Hospital at Monmouth Medical Center.

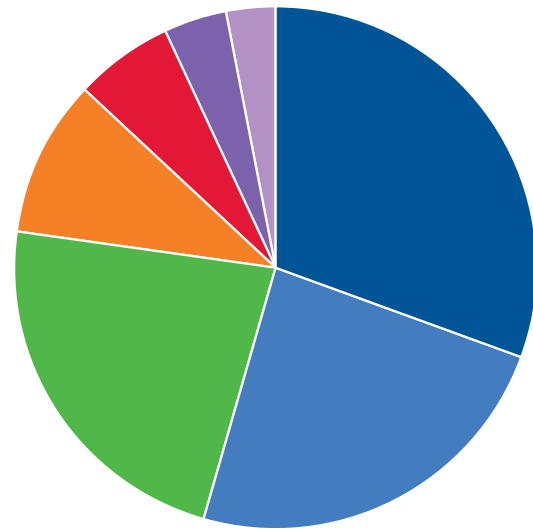

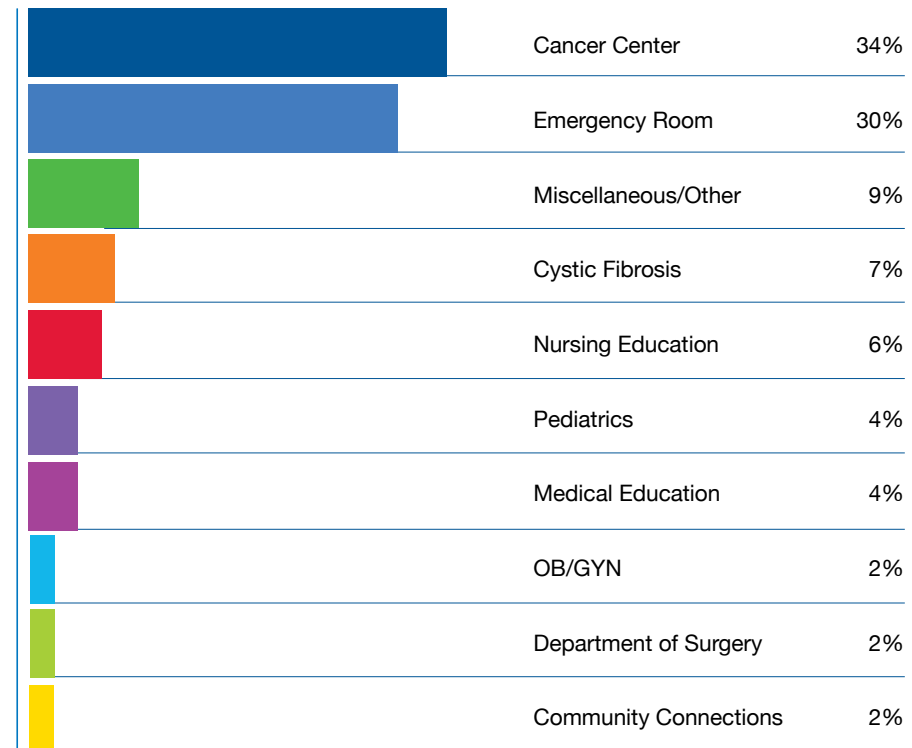

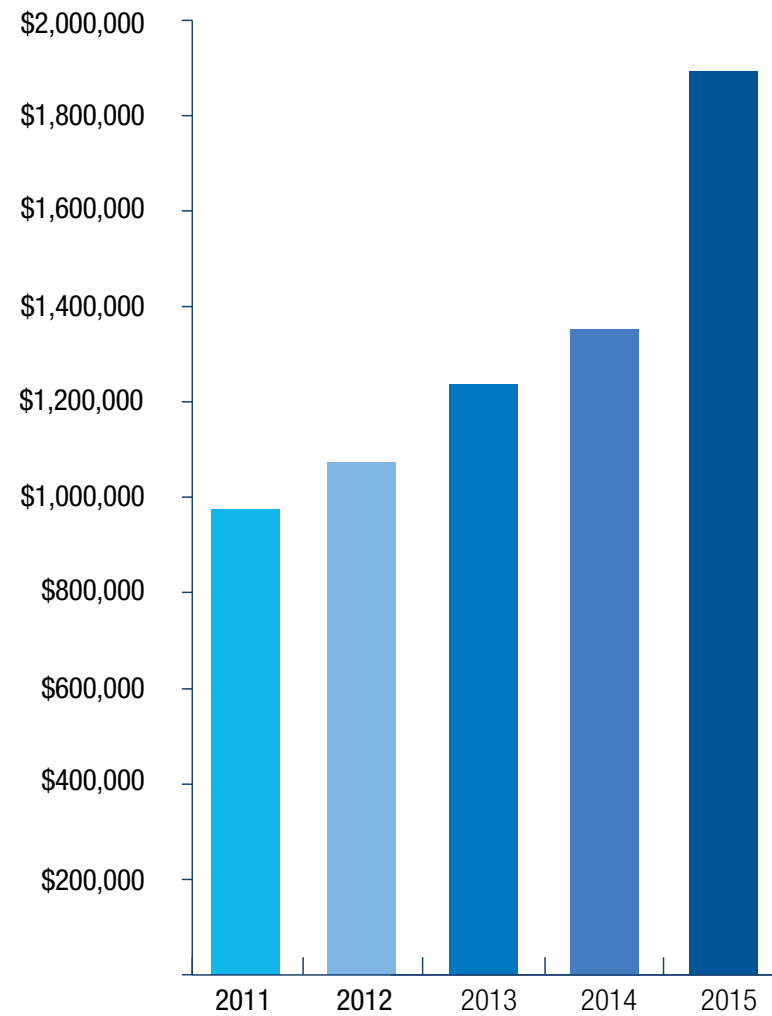
