





#### **RVCO Elections**

The RVCO elections for the 2017-2018 Board of Directors (Executive Committee) are upcoming. The positions of Treasurer, Secretary, and three (3) Members-at-Large are up for election this year, each of which shall serve a two-year term in accordance with the RVCO Constitution and Bylaws as revised at our annual meeting in August 2012.

This year's election will be held **Saturday**, **March 25 2017**, **at 12:30 p.m.**, following the *Annie Get Your Gun* sitzprobe, in the auditorium at Stage One (Summit School, 101 Plush Mill Road, Wallingford, PA 19086). All dues-paid and life members who have actively\* participated in at least one regular production within the past three years are eligible to vote.

If you wish to run for a position on the Board or nominate someone, please contact a member of the Nominating Committee listed below ASAP, but preferably not later than <u>March 18 2017</u>, so that nominees can be contacted and a printed ballot prepared if necessary; however, additional nominations may be made from the floor at the time of elections.

This is a working Board, and all officers assume tasks and chair committees that best suit their interests and abilities in conjunction with the needs of the organization. Board meetings are held monthly at the discretion of the Board. Members may serve up to three consecutive terms, or a maximum of 6 years in any Executive Committee capacity. The Board serves as the Audition Committee for each show (Board members who audition for a role may not be involved in the cast selection for that role). In order to remain a vital community theater organization, we require candidates who are prepared to make this commitment and will give their best effort in their elected positions. If you have questions about the responsibilities of any office, please direct them to the Nominating Committee named below.
