Planning a Gift to Littauer

Did you know that there are ways to give that don't affect your current lifestyle or your family's security. You can receive recognition now for certain gifts designed to the Nathan Littauer Foundation in the future.

Assets reserved in trust continue to provide income to you during your life. Trust arrangements are designed to meet your specific income needs and donor goals. Funds held in trust allow your gift to be recognized and celebrated immediately, with funds payable to Littauer from your estate.

Gifts of Appreciated Securities: For outright gifts of appreciate long-term securities, the deduction is equal to the fair market value of the securities on the date the donor relinquishes control of the assets to the Foundation. None of the appreciation is realized by the donor, thus avoiding Long Term Capital Gain taxes.

Charitable IRA Rollovers: IRS rules mandate that individuals age 70 1/2 and older take RMDs (required minimum distributions) from their IRAs each year, regardless of whether the income is needed. These annual RMDs are subject to ordinary taxes. By making a charitable contribution from your IRA, you can satisfy your RMD amount without reporting additional income.

Charitable Bequests: Donors may designate The Nathan Littauer Foundation as a beneficiary to either a fixed amount or a percentage of their estate through proper written and signed documentation.

Gifts of Life Insurance: A gift of life insurance is an excellent way to contribute to The Nathan Littauer Foundation. If you have a life insurance policy that has outlasted its original purpose, consider gifting it by designating the Foundation as owner and beneficiary.



Saying Goodbye

The Nathan Littauer Family had to recently say goodbye to Brian K. Hanaburgh, Susan A. Kiernan, and Priscilla Parkhurst Ferguson.

Mr. Brian K. Hanaburgh passed away on May 23, 2018. Brian was elected to the Nathan Littauer Hospital & Nursing Home and Colonial Health Care Corp. Boards of Directors in 2009 where he served a three-year term as President. He was also a member of the Nathan Littauer Foundation Board of Directors (2004-2009) and Chair of its “*Campaign for Excellence*”



In addition to his dedication to Littauer, Mr. Hanaburgh’s community involvement included membership on the boards of the FMCC Foundation, Lexington Foundation, Fulton County Economic Development Corp., NBT Bank, and he was the Advisory Board’s Regional Representative for the McDonald’s Corporation. Mr. Hanaburgh was also a Boy Scout Youth Leader and a recipient of its honorary “Good Scout Award.”

Miss Susan A. Kiernan

On September 2, 2018, Nathan Littauer Hospital and Nursing Home, and the Nathan Littauer Foundation lost a friend with the passing of Susan Kiernan. Sue held a key position as Vice President of Development at Littauer from October 1993 until her retirement on December 31, 2012.

Sue’s heart was centered in the community where she grew up. Her 19-year career at Littauer and her commitment to improving the health services in our rural area lead to The EVENT, Nathan Littauer’s first charitable fundraiser; along with the Foundation’s Capital Campaigns, which brought varying sectors of the community together raising millions of dollars in support of the hospital.

“*Style with panache*” describes Susan’s approach to life. She loved to travel with, and to, her friends (some which she had for over 50 years), to shop, to play golf (most proud of
