## MEET Dcn. DARREL SEGURA

My name is **Dcn. Darrell J. Segura Jr.**. I was ordained to the Transitional Diaconate on May 20, 2021. I attended Holy Trinity Seminary and studied Philosophy at the University of Dallas for four years. I am currently attending Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon for my last year of Seminary Formation.

I like to begin by describing my vocation as a “Call within a Call” to use the words of St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta. I say this because my call was twofold. ***The first call*** was when the Lord called me back home to the Catholic Church. My parents had my siblings and I baptized in the Catholic Church as infants but decided to raise us in the Baptist church. During my years as a Baptist, I learned how important it was to have a personal relationship with Jesus and I grew in my relationship with Him. It was during my teenage years that I felt the Lord calling me to the Catholic Church after experiencing the Holy Spirit speak to my heart. One Sunday, the Holy Spirit echoed Christ’s words in my heart, as the Baptist Minister read from Scripture, “Take, eat; this is my body... Drink of it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant which is poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins.” This desire to receive the Body and Blood of Jesus was the initial sign that led me to the Catholic Church. ***The second call*** was the Lord calling me to serve Him and His people as a Priest. Throughout my life, I felt the Lord calling me to be a minister. As a Baptist, this meant having a family and serving the people of God as their spiritual leader in my hometown of Raton. However, I always felt like God wanted more than that. Of course, I did not know what this was until becoming Catholic. As I lived the Catholic faith and went to Mass faithfully, I felt attracted to the Priesthood. In my heart, I felt the Lord telling me that this was the more that He wanted from me, to serve Him and His Church in a radical and beautiful way as a Priest.

## CONOSCA A Dcn. Darrel Segura

Mi nombre es **Dcn. Darrell J. Segura Jr.**. Fui ordenado al Diaconado de Transición el 20 de mayo de 2021. Asistí al Seminario Santísima Trinidad y estudié Filosofía en la Universidad de Dallas durante cuatro años. Actualmente estoy asistiendo al Seminario Mount Ángel en Oregón para mi último año de Formación en el Seminario.

Me gusta comenzar describiendo mi vocación como un “Llamado dentro de un Llamado” para usar las palabras de Santa Madre Teresa de Calcuta. Digo esto porque mi llamado fue doble. La primera llamada fue cuando el Señor me llamó de regreso a casa en la Iglesia Católica. Mis padres nos bautizaron a mis hermanos y a mí en la Iglesia Católica cuando éramos bebés, pero decidieron criarnos en la Iglesia Bautista. Durante mis años en la Iglesia Bautista, aprendí lo importante que era tener una relación personal con Jesús y crecí en mi relación con él. Fue durante mi adolescencia que sentí que el Señor me llamaba a la Iglesia Católica después de experimentar que el Espíritu Santo me hablaba al corazón. Un domingo, el Espíritu Santo hizo eco de las palabras de Cristo en mi corazón, cuando el Ministro Bautista leyó de las Escrituras: “Tomen, coman; este es mi cuerpo ... Beber todos de él; porque esto es mi sangre de la alianza que por nosotros y por muchos será derramada para el perdón de los pecados”. Este deseo de recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús fue la señal inicial que me llevó a la Iglesia Católica. El segundo llamado fue el Señor llamándome a servirle a él y a su pueblo como sacerdote. A lo largo de mi vida, sentí que el Señor me llamaba a ser ministro. Como Bautista, esto significaba tener una familia y servir al pueblo de Dios como su líder espiritual en mi ciudad natal de Ratón. Sin embargo, siempre sentí que Dios quería más que eso. Por supuesto, no sabía qué era esto hasta que me convertí en católico. Mientras vivía la fe católica y asistía fielmente a misa, me sentí atraído por el sacerdocio. En mi corazón, sentí que el Señor me decía que esto era “lo más” que quería de mí, servirle a Él y a Su Iglesia de una manera radical y hermosa como Sacerdote.





## LIVE THE LITURGY

### Inspiration for the week

Presumption can be a great sin. We can easily convince ourselves that as long as we do the bare minimum or master the basics, it is sufficient. Love doesn't operate this way. If we are truly in love with God, then the basics are not going to be enough. That love is going to want to get expressed in going above and beyond, in leaving the comfortable and familiar, in stretching and growing and in following a voice other than our own. This is what those who are truly in pursuit of wisdom come to realize. Just like any human relationship worth achieving reveals, we never reach a plateau in following the Gospel or growing in wisdom and holiness. Wisdom is the rudder that guides us through all of life's attractions and options. It alone determines what is worth pursuing and what must be left behind. That is why those who are only concerned about checking the boxes and doing the least amount possible often walk away sad when offered God's gift of life eternal. They are not truly in love.



### SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Teresa of Ávila (1515-1582) was a Spanish Carmelite nun who lived in the 16th century. She was a mystic and author of spiritual writings and poems. The originator of the Carmelite Reform, she founded numerous convents throughout Spain and restored a contemplative life to the order. She became well known for the mystical experiences, many of which she described in her autobiography.

The first of only four women to be named a Doctor of the Church, St. Teresa's ascetic doctrine and Carmelite reforms shaped Roman Catholic contemplative life, and her writings on the Christian soul's journey to God are considered works of art. Her writings, especially the "Way of Perfection" and "The Interior Castle," have helped generations of believers.

St. Teresa of Avila died on Oct. 15, 1582. She was canonized on March 22, 1622, along with three of her greatest contemporaries: St. Ignatius Loyola, St. Francis Xavier, and St. Philip Neri.
