





PEW INSTALLATION

Our Pew removal and installation will occur between July 12 - July 29.



FAITH MATTERS

REACH OUT AND HEAR HIS CALL

When I was in the middle of middle school, my family moved from Texas (a suburb of Houston) back to southern New Jersey (near where I was born) because my father's assignment there ended. Unfortunately, I experienced serious bullying in my new school and due in part to that suffering, my parents and I decided I should attend a private Catholic high school in Delaware, Salesianum in Wilmington. When I began high school, I had withdrawn into a protective shell that let no one and nothing in. In many ways, I was dead to the world around me. I wanted nothing to do with socializing, extracurriculars, or people. Thankfully, my parents knew that wasn't healthy and forced me to join marching band. (I played the tuba!) By the time I was a senior, I was the drum major of the marching band, a member of every band they offered, and even ventured on stage with a small part in the spring musical (the Mysterious Old Man in Into the Woods). I was alive again! Alive enough to even begin dating. Sadly, as you might expect a ridiculously inexperienced boy to do, I made a mistake (that's a bittersweet and, now, funny story for another time) and ended high school with a broken heart. I overreacted and cut myself off from romance for many years thereafter, never dating throughout college or grad school. And in that decision, I suffered again, not traumatically but slowly, an important part of myself bleeding away over time, years and years of denying myself experiences and opportunities to grow as a person. In the longer version of today's Gospel, Jesus heals two people. Most dramatically, he brings the young daughter of Jairus, a synagogue official, back to life, calling her from the bed on which she lay. I probably would have laid on my bed throughout high school had my parents not intervened. They played Jesus in my life, calling me back to life. Then a woman who'd been bleeding with hemorrhages for many years received healing, even before asking for it, just by reaching out to Jesus. My years of denying the part of myself that yearned for romantic love finally healed when in seminary for priesthood I spent enough time with Jesus in prayer that I finally recognized my own worth in a way that opened the door to being open to the idea of someone loving me. Jesus healed me of my low self esteem, which then healed me of my fear of relationship, when then led to my wife, all in the same summer (another story for another time). Jesus continues to resurrect and heal today. Which do you need? Will you reach out? Will you hear his call to life?
