BIBLE CORNER

TODAY WE PONDER: PHILIPPIANS 2:10
“At the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven, and on earth, and under the earth.”

Since it would be difficult to kneel every time the name of Jesus is spoken, Pope Gregory, in 1274, enjoined the Dominican Order to find a more practical way to revere the Sacred Name. They were inspired with the thought of a simple gesture of bowing one's head whenever the name was spoken. This simple gesture is meant to reflect an internal desire to honor the “Name Above All Names” – Jesus – who gave His life for our salvation.

Somehow after 747 years, this beautiful gesture has been cast aside in the last few decades. Some people still bow their heads, but the majority do not. What caused this change? Isn't Jesus still worthy of respect and reverence? Is this the first time you heard of this tradition? Wouldn't it be wonderful to see your children and grandchildren bow their little heads? Isn't it time to resurrect this and other neglected Catholic traditions? A simple gesture could demonstrate to the world that we “stand-up Catholics” love Jesus and are proud of our faith.

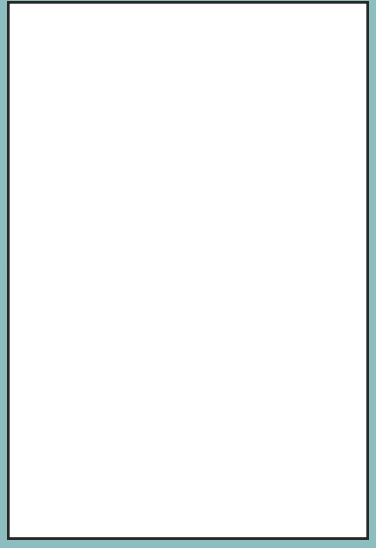
