### A NOTE FROM FR. DEREK



This Saturday, at 10:00 AM at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross in Boston, Cardinal Séan will ordain five men as new priests for service in the Archdiocese of Boston. Please keep in your prayers Deacons Fernando Ayala, David Campo, Robert LeBlanc, Jr., Leonardo Moreira and Kevin Pleitez as they prepare for this day and begin to share in the ministry of Jesus

Christ the High Priest. The ordination, for those who wish to watch, is usually broadcast on Catholic TV and can be viewed online at www.catholictv.org.

While this is a day of great celebration, it is important to remember that this group of five ordinands is not like that of days gone by when there were twenty or more ordained at once. We live in a day and an age when it is more difficult for young men to hear the call to priestly ministry and, when they hear it, to respond. It is more and more important for us, these days, to be encouraging young men whom we think would make good priests to consider that God may be calling them as well as to be praying for vocations. Perhaps you would make your own the Archdiocesan Vocation Prayer written by Cardinal Séan:

Holy Mother of the Good Shepherd, turn your motherly care to our Diocese. Intercede for us to the Lord of the Harvest to send more laborers to the harvest. Inspire vocations in our time. Let the word of your Son be made flesh anew in the lives of persons anxious to proclaim the Good News of everlasting life. Draw them near to the heart of your Son so that they can understand the beauty and joy that awaits them to be His witnesses. Amen.

# RESUMPTION OF CONGREGATIONAL SINGING

Provided that the numbers regarding the ongoing pandemic continue to trend in a favorable direction, the Archdiocese has given parishes the permission to resume congregational singing. We are anticipating resuming congregational singing here at St. Bartholomew's on Pentecost Weekend (May 22/23). This will include returning to the singing of the Gloria and the Responsorial Psalm, as well as the hymns. Choir singing will not return at this time as we simply do not have enough space for choir members to remain a safe distance from one another. As we resume singing we would encourage you not to sing with full-force at this time and remind you that everyone should be wearing a mask that fits well and covers their mouth and nose.

Because we still cannot have hymnals in the pews, to assist you we are planning the following:

- To have a link on the Signup Genius page to a PDF document with the words of the Psalm and hymns for that Mass which you can download to your device or print up at home and bring with you.
- To have QR codes available at the doors of the church so that you can access the same PDF file as you enter the church.
- For those who do not do computers / Internet, we
  will have a few copies available at the door of the
  church. These will be single-use only and all papers
  (whether picked up at church or brought from home)
  should be put in recycling bins as you leave Mass.

At this time we will also resume having a procession at the beginning of Mass, but only of the lector and the priest.

# Saint Bede the Venerable

673-725 FEAST DAY: MAY 25

Born in Northumbria, in northern England, Bede was schooled at the Benedictine monasteries of Wearmouth and Jarrow, where he spent the rest of his life as a monk and priest. "Study, teaching and writing have always been my delight," he wrote. He penned extensive biblical and theological writings, but his fame came as a historian. His most valuable work was "Ecclesiastical History of the English People." In 836, a church council at Aachen, Germany, called him the Venerable Bede and Pope Leo XIII declared him a doctor of the church in 1899.




