Scripture Reflection

Paul's back! After last week's "violent abuse," opponents organized a lynch mob that beat Paul nearly to death. But call Paul the "energizing evangelist," transforming deadly cruelty into life-giving zeal. Paul's past courage should inspire our commitment; Revelation's future "new heaven, new earth" should inspire our optimism. But Revelation's present assurance, "Behold, God's dwelling is with the human race," should challenge us to become "missionaries of mercy." Because Pope Francis declared that the Church's credibility is completely dependent on our showing unconditional mercy. Mercy, said Francis, makes the Church, the world, and everyone young again, reawakened to life's noblest virtues. Fittingly, in today's Gospel Jesus reinforces that theme: "This is how all will know you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

St Catherine SVdP Planning Drive for Ozanam Inn



The St. Catherine of Siena Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) is planning a drive to help Ozanam Inn, which was named in honor of Frederick Ozanam, who founded the Society in 1852. Located at 843 Camp Street and operational since 1955, Ozanam Inn operates by the principle, "Give a fish to eat today and teach to fish for tomorrow!"

These supportive services are available from Ozanam Inn, FREE to anyone in need, male and female: **Humanitarian**—food (three meals a day), shelter and showers (men only at the shelter), and vouchers for women and children to stay at nearby shelters; **Counseling Services**—case management, life skills training, anger management, substance abuse counseling, alcoholics anonymous, and narcotics anonymous (12-step program); **Medical Services** (through partnerships with LSU and Tulane medical schools and Crescent City Vision)—health care screenings, tuberculosis testing, HIV/AIDS testing, health care awareness, dental health care, and eye exam referrals; and **Medications/Pharmacy**—prescription and over the counter medicines.

Ozanam Inn offers assistance with **Employment Skills**—employment readiness and resume writing/building training, job search assistance, interview skills, and computer training; **Spiritual Services** (optional)—on-site chapel and spiritual counseling sessions offered by visiting pastors, deacons, and ministers; **Legal Counsel/Basic Needs**—legal counsel and notary public assistance; social security representation; state identification cards, driver's licenses, and birth certificates; mail receipt and distribution; transportation assistance; eyeglass distribution (reading); and haircuts; and **Housing Programs**—permanent supportive housing with intense care management, permanent independent housing, rapid re-housing, and housing search assistance/inspections.
