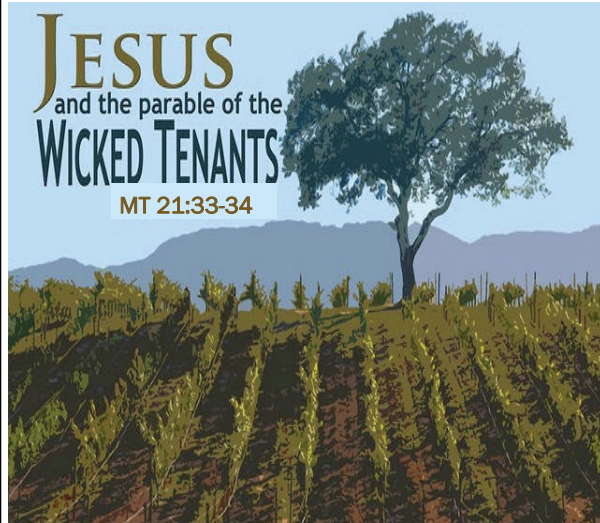

Indications are that the collection is down about \$1,000 per week which is the cause of the deficit. Appropriate actions now need to be taken to deal with our financial situation. Meetings are being held, and soon we will call the Finance Council together to help us make decisions.
