Hear to Serve ...



"TRUE BELIEVERS"

For Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, we have the option of four different Gospels to be read at the Masses. They are from Matthew, Luke, and John. This year we tell the story of the birth of Jesus through the words of Luke. This story is the one we share with our families, through the nativity scenes we set up in our homes and at church. This is the beautiful story that our children tell as they dress up as shepherds and angels for the Christmas pageant.

My favorite Christmas reading comes from the Gospel of John. This Gospel tells the story of the coming of Jesus in a very different but equally moving way. "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came to be through Him, and without Him nothing came to be. And what came to be through Him was life" (John 1:1-3).

John does not give the details of the birth of Jesus. Instead, he directs our attention to who Jesus really is. John's Gospel brings "Light" to the true character of Jesus. He reminds us that Jesus is God. Jesus didn't come to reveal God so to speak but came as God revealed to the human race. God has humbled Himself to share in our humanity. Jesus came to be part of all our joys and our sorrows.

Normally, our main worry at Christmas is that we don't get caught up in the secular consumerism of the world. But this Christmas Season is a little tougher. Because of the pandemic, we have been separated from loved ones, and traditions have been altered. Even our mode of shopping has changed. We worry if we visit our loved ones. We worry if we don't.

This Christmas Season it is more important than ever to make time to sit back and reflect on what the true meaning of Christmas really is and who Jesus really is. What is this life that we will get through Jesus? The light of hope, peace, joy, and love do not come by putting our faith in the secular world, or by trusting in ourselves. The light we are looking for, the light we need is the light of Christ.

"He was in the world, and the world came to be through Him. But the world did not know Him" (John 1:10). Isn't it great that our gift of eternal life doesn't depend on us knowing all the facts? Our gift of everlasting life depends on the conversion of our hearts and our attitudes. Can we lay down our hearts, our attitudes, and our lives for Jesus the Christ?

Let us become "TRUE BELIEVERS" this Christmas Season. Let us become like John and cry out to the world. Let us be able to give testimony to the "Light of the World" just like John the Baptist did. I urge you to read this Christmas Gospel of John 1:1-18. Make it part of your New Year's resolution to take the time to read the entire Gospel of John.

"But these things are written that you may believe that Jesus is Messiah, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in His name" (John 20: 31).
