SYNOD LISTENING SESSIONS CONTINUE

The Synod Listening Sessions are continuing this Sunday, **March 27th after the 9:00 a.m.** Mass in the School Cafeteria; **Sunday, April 3rd at 7:00 p.m.** on-line through Zoom; **Wednesday, April 20th at 7:00 p.m.** in the Fellowship Hall. The purpose of these listening sessions is to provide an opportunity for parishioners to prayerfully enter into a dialogue about St. Henry's future. In particular, we are called by the Vatican in the *Vademecum* for the Synod on Synodality, the Official Handbook for Listening and Discernment in Local Churches to take "special care . . . to involve those persons who may risk being excluded: women, the handicapped, refugees, migrants, the elderly, people who live in poverty, Catholics who rarely or never practice their faith, etc."

At the first listening session 30 to 40 parishioners including a number of women and people over the age of 65 came together and entered into a lively dialogue in several groups with the discussions lasting for an hour and forty-five minutes. That was a good start; however, it was just that – a good start. Please consider coming to one of the future sessions either in person or on-line, AND consider bringing along a friend you know who is "handicapped, a refugee, a migrant, poor or who rarely or never practices his/her faith." St. Henry is a very special place to me. It is my spiritual home. It is also a very rich parish in many ways. By being rich, we are called to reach out to the poor and marginalized not just to help them with their financial needs but to hear from them about how we can better be a community of faith that opens its doors to all.

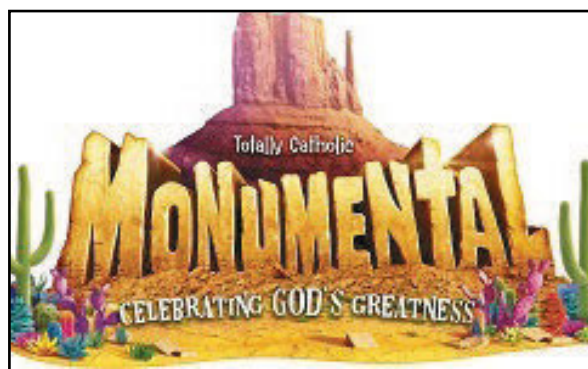

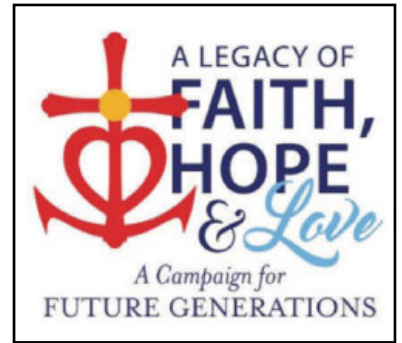
