From the Desk of Fr. John Tran

Divine Mercy Sunday

The Divine Mercy is not a new teaching of the Church. Thanks to Saint Pope John Paul II for establishing the Divine Mercy Sunday, especially to St. Faustina for promoting the devotion to the Divine Mercy in a very special way. Her life and her Diary sparked a great movement, a strong and magnificent focus on the mercy of Christ. At her canonization Pope John Paul called her "the Great Apostle of Divine Mercy in our time."

The central message of Divine Mercy is a call to trust in Jesus' endless mercy, and to live life mercifully toward others. So here we see in the message of Divine Mercy a twofold call (twofold invitation):

First: a call, an invitation to trust in Jesus' endless mercy, to come and receive his mercy, to live and experience his mercy in our lives. There are many channels through which he bestows his mercy upon us, one of them is confession. In the Holy Year of Mercy years ago, Pope Francis called us to hasten to that door, the Holy Door of the Divine Mercy).

Second: to bring his love and mercy to others, helping them, especially sinners to come, to see, to receive and experience his mercy in their lives. In doing so, with St. Faustina and with Pope John Paul we too become Great Apostles of Divine Mercy in our time."

In 2002, Pope John Paul entrusted the whole world to Divine Mercy when he consecrated the International Shrine of The Divine Mercy in Lagiewniki, a suburb of Krakow in Poland. Today once again let us join together to entrust the whole world, especially Russia and Ukraine to Divine Mercy.

Lord Jesus, we trust in you! St. Faustina, St. Pope John Paul, pray for us and help us to trust in Jesus as you did and thus to glorify His Mercy in the whole world and in every moment of our lives. Jesus, I trust in You. Jezu Ufan Tobie.
